Instruction Sheet Front Lower Shock Bushings

N.B: This instruction sheet should be used in conjunction with the workshop manual

Note - these bushings are to suit a 35mm shock bush eye

Application - Mitsubishi Triton ML MN

- Mitsubishi Challenger PB

1. Raise vehicle evenly and safely support.

(Always refer current catalogue for complete listings

Never rely on a Jack only

2. Remove front wheels and proceed to un-bolt upper control arm via ball joint bolts and inner bushing bolts.

Contents - Shell bushing 92028 x2

- Steel tube 19 x 14.3 x 48 x2

Upper strut mount bolts

- Grease

Caution - the upper arm will be resting on the rubber droop stop. You may wish to lift/jack the lower arm up an inch or so.

3. Remove lower shock bushing bolt and proceed to un-bolt the 3 upper strut top nuts.

A hydraulic Press will be required to press out the lower bushing.

- 4. Proceed to press out old bushing including steel outer shell.
- 5. Press in new shell bushing.
- 6. Grease bushing internal diameter with supplied grease only.
- 7. Push in supplied steel tube.
- 8. Re-assemble vehicle.
