
## **Radius Rod to Control Arm Bushes**

## Ford Falcon, Fairlane, LTD Suits 11/87-7/98 EA/NA/DA - EL/NL/DL

**N.B:** These instructions should be used in conjunction with workshop manual.

**N.B:** This kit contains bushes with bonded washers for added strength, thus eliminating the risk of damage caused to the flange under heavy braking.

- 1. Raise the front of the vehicle and support on chassis stands.
- 2. Remove the front wheels from the vehicle.
- 3. Undo the front and rear nuts and washers from both ends of the radius rod and remove from the vehicle.
- 4. Remove old bushes from the control arm.
- 5. Clean and remove any rubber deposits and inspect control arm for damage repair or replace if necessary.
- 6. Lubricate end faces and internal bore only of the bushes with grease provided, before assembly.
- 7. Re-use original washers and nuts and refit new bushes to the control arm making sure to fit them the correct way (see diagram below).
- 8. Tighten all components to manufacturers recommended torque settings.
- 9. Wheel align vehicle.



NB: It is recommended that a licenced workshop or trades person carry out the above procedure and that workshop manual procedures are followed in addition to the above.
