FITTING INSTRUCTIONS

N.B: These instructions should be used in conjunction with workshop manual.

- 1. Raise the front of vehicle and support with chassis stands; remove front wheels from the vehicle.
- 2. Disconnect the ball joint and sway bar links from the lower control arms, remove the front control arm bolts

N.B: PT Cruiser vehicles require removal of the lower right hand engine mount to gain access to the right hand front Control arm bolt.

- 3. Remove the control arms from the vehicle.
- 4. Remove the old rear bushes from the control arms using a puller or similar tool.
- 5. Clean and inspect the arm, where the new bushes are to be fitted for rust, paint, damage, pitting and rubber deposits and clean or replace as necessary.
- 6. Fit the new bushes to the arm, ensuring that the bush with the bonded washer is the lower bush (i.e.) faces the underside of the arm, as per diagram 1.
- 7. Lubricate the internal bore and thrust faces of the bushes with the grease supplied, and fit the metal crush tube to the bushes as per diagram 2.
- 8. Refit the arm to the vehicle whilst inserting the washer supplied to the gap between the top of upper bush and sub frame as per diagram 1.
- 9. Refit all bolts, ball joints and sway bar links to vehicle using the manufacturer specifications and torque settings.
- 10. It is recommended that a wheel alignment be carried out following the installation of these bushes, including a road test to ensure proper fitment.
