# Central Locking Fitting Instructions For HardLid

- 1. Install all electrical components first (1 of 3) (electrical components are supplied seperately)
- 2. Install Vehicle Tub Sealing Kit (2 of 3)
- 3. Install vehicle tub protective products such as tub liners\*
- 4. Install styling bar onto HardLid
- 5. Install the HardLid Fitting Kit (3 of 3)
- 6. Install the HardLid (3 of 3)
- 7. Install any additional accessories such as roof racks.

\*HardLid is compatible with under rail and Sport Guard style tub liners. Some trimming may be required. OEM liner compatibility cannot be guaranteed. Please contact your dealer for more information.

 HardLid is supplied with 400N Gas Struts which are suitable for an unloaded lid. Recommended maximum loading of 25 kgs when opening the lid. If you require your lid to remain open whilst loaded, you will need to purchase a Heavy Load Strut Upgrade Kit which is available through your local dealer. Please use one of the following part numbers as a reference when contacting your dealer:

- Read through the fitting instructions before installation of accessory.
- Check that the contents of the Fitting Kit are complete and undamaged.
- If any contents of the Fitting Kit are found incomplete or damaged they must be replaced using the specified accessory components.

- Ensure all recyclable discarded vehicle/accessory components and packaging are disposed following local recycling regulations.
- Safely store and protect any removed vehicle components.
- Ensure all bare metal surfaces are protected using Automotive Bare Metal Primer and touch-up paint.
- · Remove all metal swarf and dust from all vehicle surfaces.
- Ensure all fasteners are torqued to the specifications as per instruction.
- Apply any adhesives to the vehicle only when the surface temperature is between 20°C to 40°C.
- **Bedliner:** Recommended rust preventative solution be applied to vehicle surfaces before installation.

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
## Step 1

• This instruction is only for the installation of central locking componets into the HardLid. Additional componets and instructions are required for vehicle patch harness installation. Please refer to the Table 1 for vehicle specific kits.

#### Step 2

- Place the lid upside down on a flat surface.
- Remove the service cover by extracting 8 X M6 button head screws.
- Ensure the Emergency Exit Handle is detached from the Velcro pad before removing the cover.








#### Step 4

- Insert the central locking loom (2) into the large hole at the front of the frame.
- Run the loom down the length of the frame and out of the hole preceding the latch.
- Ensure the loom sits above the latching cables.



## Step 5


· Remove the screw, washers and locking cable assembly from the central lock.



#### Step 6


 Install the locking module and cir-clip (1). Ensure the locking module connectors are facing toward the left hand side of the lid. Reinstall the screw, washers & locking cable assembly. Torque to 4NM.

IMPORTANT: Perform a manual unlocking test by twisting the lock handle. This is to ensure the cables have been reinstalled in the correct orientation.




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# Step 9

- At the centre of the HardLid, measure backward from the service cover 90-95mm.
- Clean and prime the surface using the alcohol wipes (5) and surface primer (3).
- Remove the backing strips from the dome lamp (4), stick the dome lamp into position with the on/off switch facing toward the rear of the vehicle.



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
