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GENERAL CARE AND MAINTENANCE

- Prior to exposure to the weather your bar should be treated to a Carnauba based polish on all exposed surfaces. It is recommended that this is performed on a six monthly basis or following exposure to salt, mud, sand or other contaminants.
- As part of any Pre Trip Preparation, or on an annual basis, it is recommended that a thorough visual inspection of the bar is carried out, making sure that all bolts and other components are torqued to the correct specification. Also check that all wiring sheaths, connectors, and fittings are free of damage. Replace any components as necessary. This service can be performed by your local authorized ARB Stockist.

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


FITTING PROCEDURE



1. Remove number plate and screws. Retain all items. (NB: Laramie model shown in most photos)



2. Disconnect all electrical and wiring looms located behind the bumper on the LHS including Driving Lights, Indicator Lights and FPA Sensor loom (If present).

FPA Sensor loom - disconnected





3. If equipped, remove 2x OE tow hooks, 2x M12 bolts and 4x M12 nuts using an 18mm deep socket and discard (If present).

Items discarded:



4. Remove 2x upper bumper M12 retaining nuts (*taking care to support the bumper*) using an A/F 18mm deep socket and wrench. Discard the nuts.



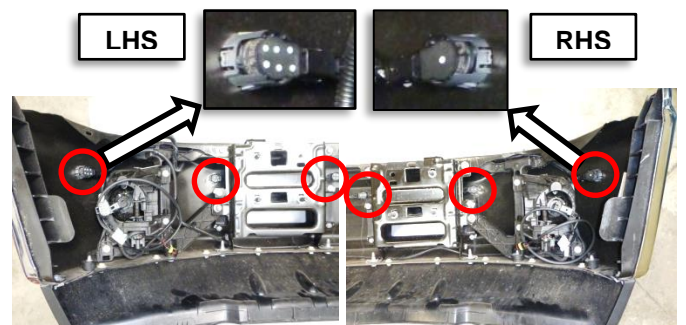

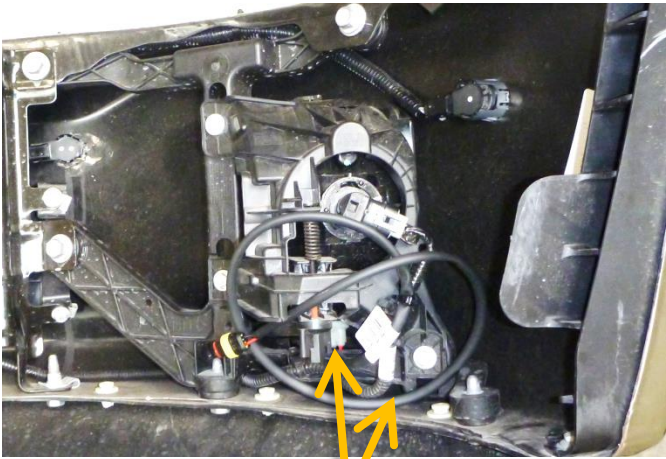
5. For Laramie vehicles, remove lower chrome bumper from vehicle and place face down on a soft non-marking surface.

6. **For vehicles with FPA Sensors:**

Record the unique location of each sensor and housing combination. For example; using a white paint pen, use "dot patterns" to mark the back of each housing / sensor set from the RHS 1x dot through to the LHS 6x dots, as shown below;

7. Vehicles that have been homologated for use in Australia have been fitted with additional clearance lights inside the base of the fog lamps in the bumper.
8. Remove the light and loom from the OE fog lamp as these will be used to connect the 6821287 ARB LED and indicator clearance lamps included in the kit.

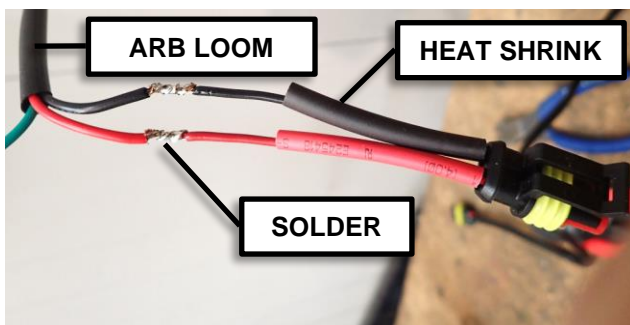

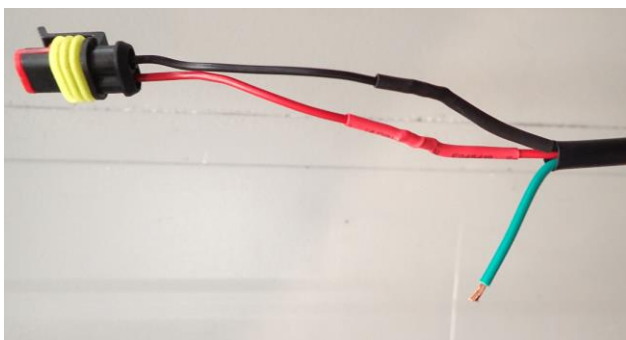


9. Strip back the black outer sheath at the connector end by approximately 100mm
10. Cut through both black and red wires at approximately 70mm from connector end.
11. Discard lamp end.

ENDS RETAINED (x2)



12. Unpack both 3 core looms from the ARB indicator kit 6821287.
13. Using wire strippers and solder, join the red and black wires on the ARB loom to the corresponding red and black wires on the trimmed loom retained above and check electrical continuity.



14. Once sturdy electrical connections have been made, insulate the joints with heat shrink or electrical tape.



15. The access point in the wheel arch liner must be opened. Gently remove the lower scrivet to gain access as shown.
16. In order to ensure adequate access to the vehicle's lighting looms, loosen the M6 screw several turns to enable removal of the black earth wire shown.
17. Repeat for opposite side of vehicle.

18. Disengage the large connector from the base of both headlights and gently pull them down below the headlight clusters.
19. Power supply for the ARB LED indicator can be taken from this plug on both sides of the vehicle as shown below;

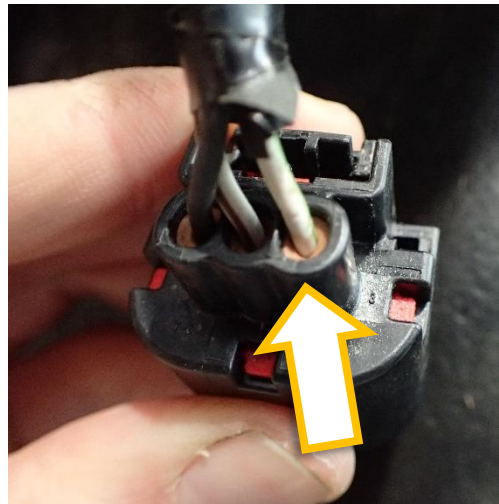

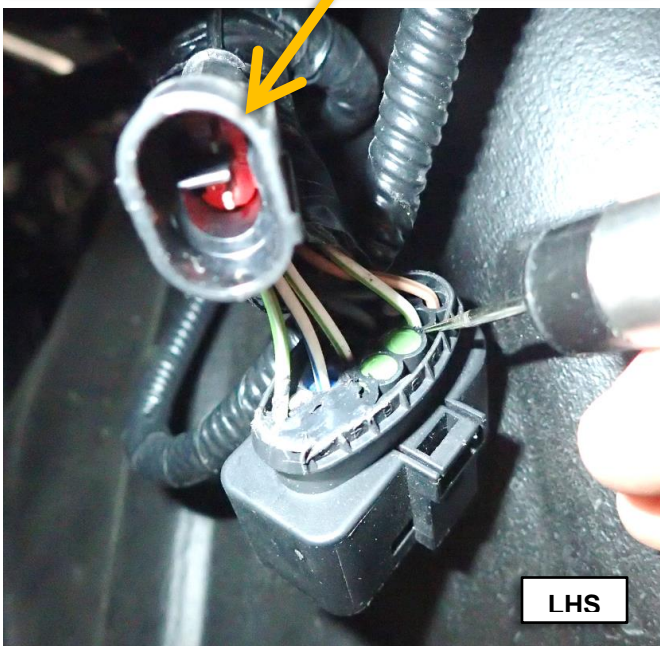

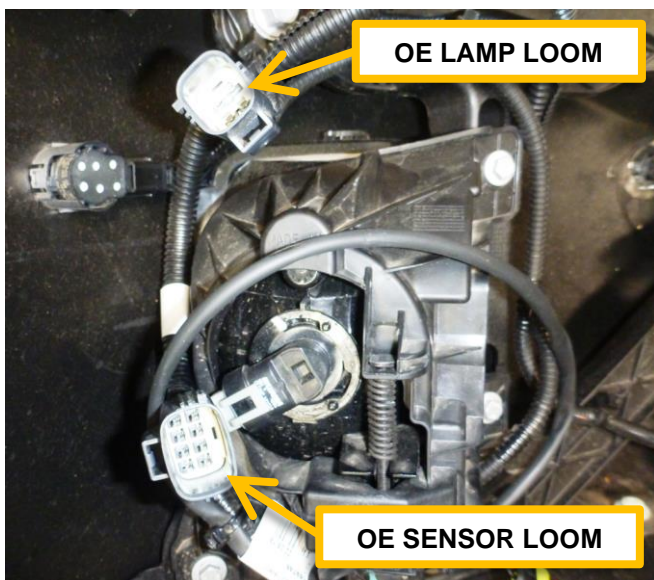

20. Using wire strippers and solder join the green indicator wire on the ARB LED Indicator loom to the corresponding wires described above.
21. Once sturdy electrical connections have been made, reconnect the clearance loom connector to the vehicle and insulate with heat shrink or electrical tape.
22. Reconnect each plug into the headlamp cluster and secure the earth lead back under the M6 screw loosened in Step 16.
23. Repeat for each side of vehicle.

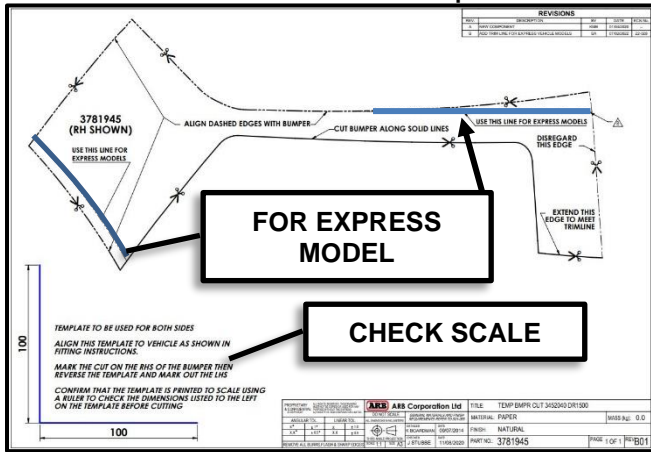
24. Disconnect, remove and retain all sensors, sensor housings, silicone sleeves and remaining OE Lamp and Sensor looms from bumper if present.
25. Discard bumper (LARAMIE) and OE fog lamps.

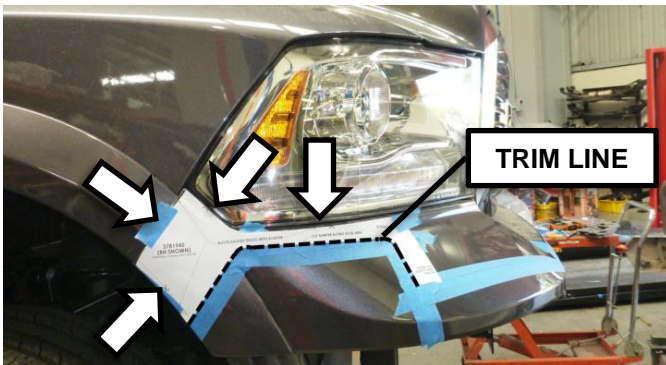


CRITICAL: Upper bumper trim (on vehicle)

26. Carefully cut out the trim template shown at left ensuring that the template is to scale by first measuring the two axes which should be 100mm long each. (NB: RHS template shown, reverse for use on LHS)

CRITICAL: See alternate cutting line on template for Express Models.

27. On RHS: carefully position trim template prepared in Step 26 by aligning with features on bumper as indicated.

28. Apply non-marking tape along "dotted" trim line areas, then proceed to mark out.

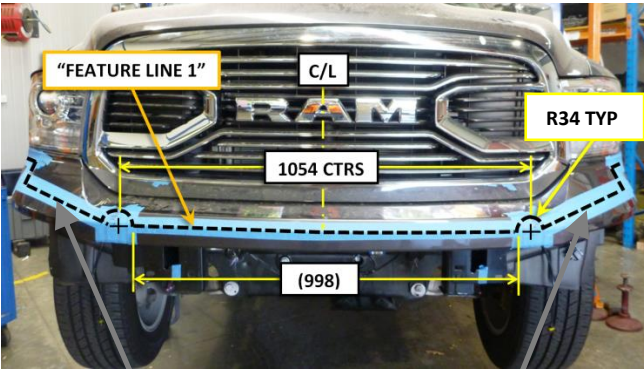
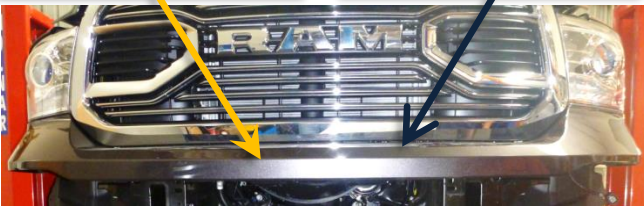

- 29. Carefully remove template from RHS. Use in reverse to tape and mark out LHS.
- 30. Tape and mark out long dashed lines shown at left following the "feature line 1" at front of bumper and connecting to RHS and LHS trim template profiles as shown at left. Use the logo on the grille to obtain centre line reference.
- 31. Carefully use a multi-tool to trim bumper along "dotted" lines shown at left



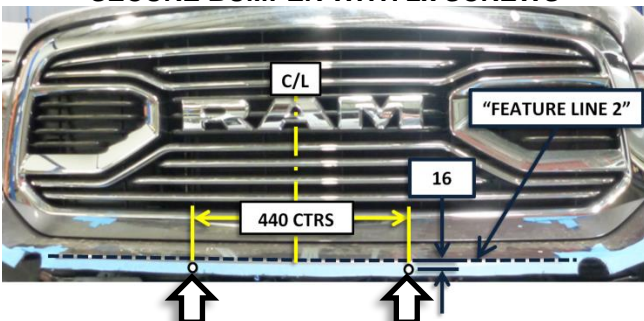

- 32. For Express models, remove and discard the lower section of the cut bumper and impact absorber structure.

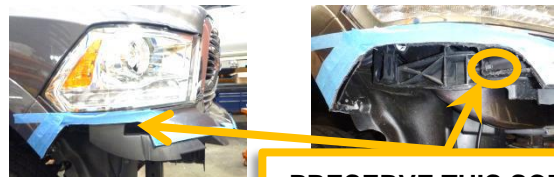


SECURE BUMPER WITH 2x SCREWS

- 33. Mark out and remove the sections of the moulding that sit exposed directly behind the trimmed bumper, preserving the RHS/LHS mount screws as shown below.

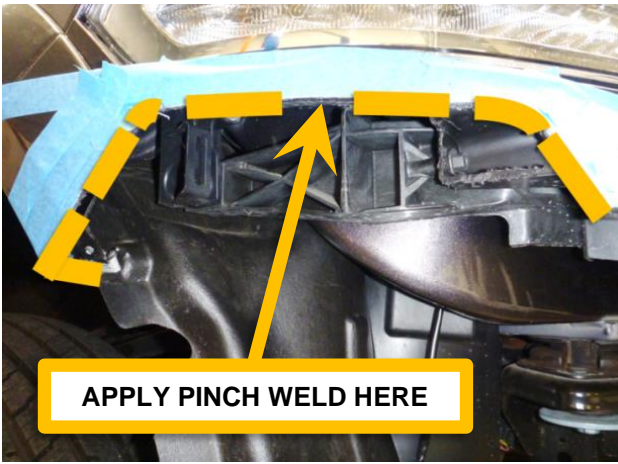

- 34. Secure bumper to support moulding with 2x screws ST PHD 8Gx15 TZP as shown at left

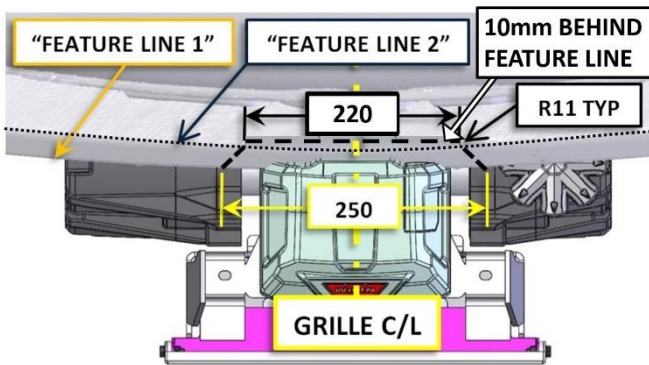

35. Use a file or sandpaper to de-bur all cut edges.
36. Apply a strip of continuous pinch weld to the outermost sides of the trimmed bumper and return inside the wheel arch area. RHS shown LHS opposite

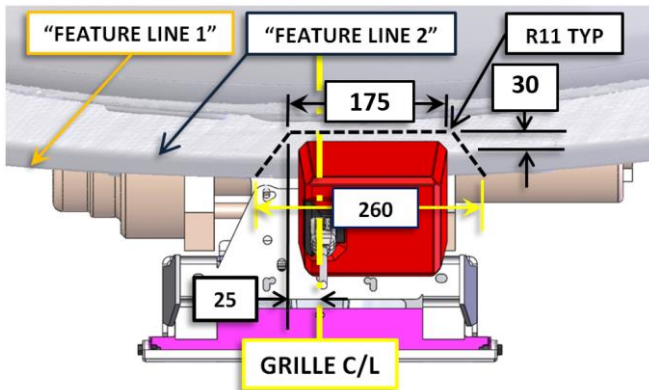

37. **ALL OTHER WINCHES** (Warn EVO shown): Tape and mark out dashed lines shown at left following "feature line 2" and terminating on "feature line 1" then carefully use a multi-tool to trim bumper along dashed lines, removing centre section indicated.
38. Apply pinch weld to trimmed area.

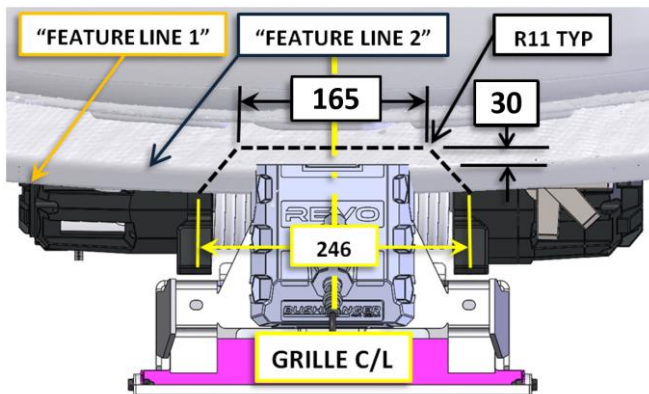


39. **Warn XD9000, 9.5XP, M12, M8000** (with Solid State Control Box): Tape, and mark out dashed lines shown at left using "feature line 2" as a guide and terminating on "feature line 1", then carefully use a multi-tool to trim bumper along "dotted" lines, removing centre section indicated.
40. Apply pinch weld to trimmed area.

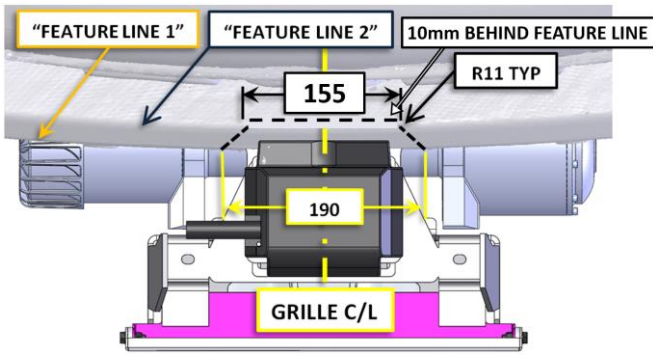


41. **Bushranger REVO** (With Ctrl Box mounted horizontally): Tape, and mark out dashed lines shown at left using "feature line 2" as a guide and terminating on "feature line 1", then carefully use a multi-tool to trim bumper along "dotted" lines, removing centre section indicated.
42. Apply pinch weld to trimmed area.

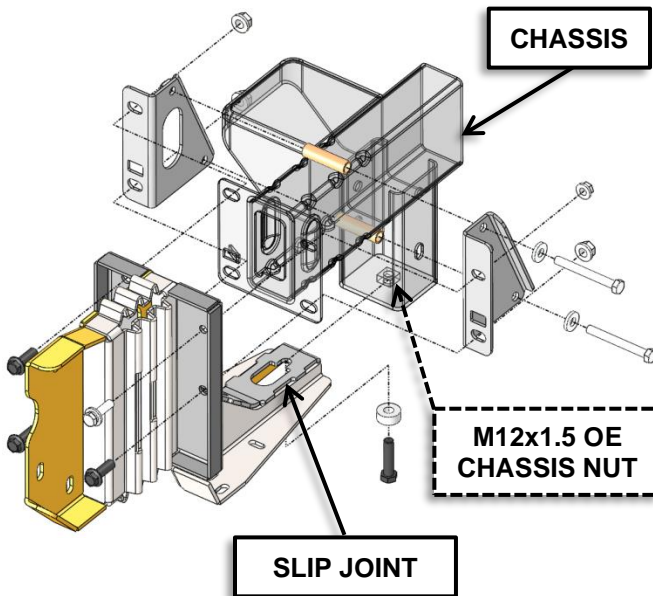
43. **Smittybilt GEN 1 & 2:** Tape and mark out dashed lines shown at left following "feature line 2" and terminating on "feature line 1" then carefully use a multi-tool to trim bumper along dashed lines, removing centre section indicated.

44. Apply pinch weld to trimmed area.

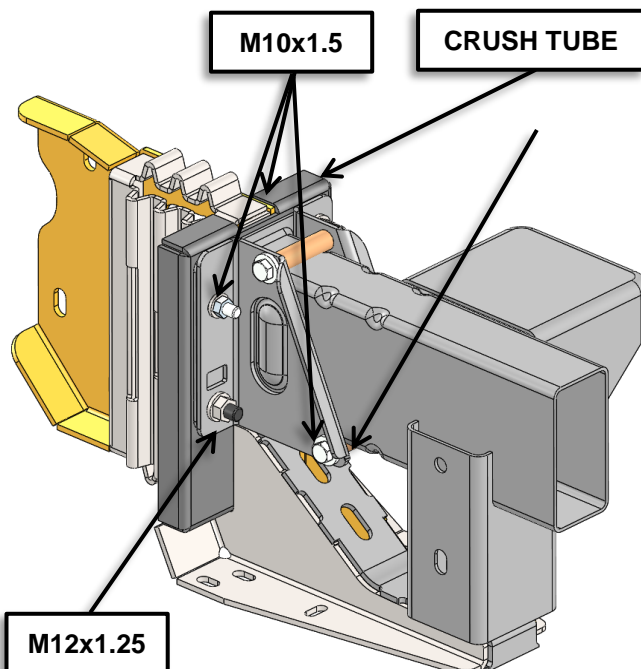


Assemble mount brackets to chassis:

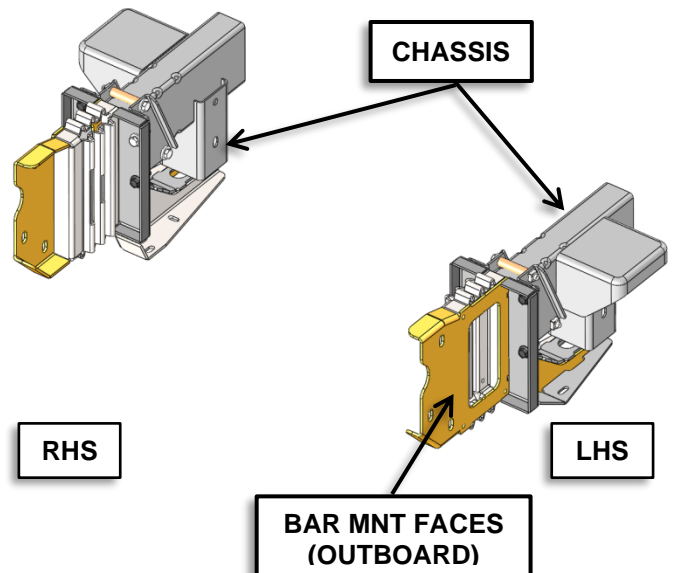
45. **RHS shown, LHS opposite:** Loosely fasten the chassis mounts and rear brackets to the front of the chassis using; 6x Bolt Hex Head Flange Screws M12x1.25x35, 6x Nut Flange M12x1.25, 2x Screw SEMS M10x1.5x40, 2x Nut Flange M10x1.5. Insert 4x chassis crush tubes between the rear mount brackets and loosely secure with 4x Bolt Hex Head M10x1.5x90 and 4x Washer M10x25x4.

46. Loosely secure the slip joint at the chassis base using; 2x Bolt Hex Head M12x1.5x50, 2x Spacer M12 x OD29 x ID12.5x12 into the OE chassis nut located inside the base of the chassis.

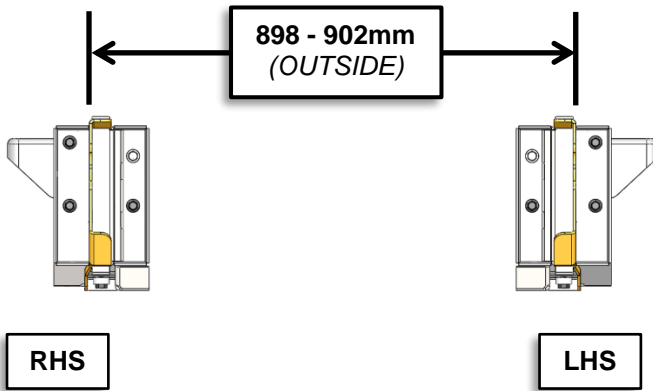

47. Check that the upright mounting faces are vertical and approximately 898 - 902mm apart overall.
48. Begin tightening all fasteners starting with 2x M12x1.5x50 chassis base screws, 6x M12x1.25 and 2x M10x1.5 front chassis mount screws ensuring that the mount brackets pull up evenly at all secured locations until final torque is reached.

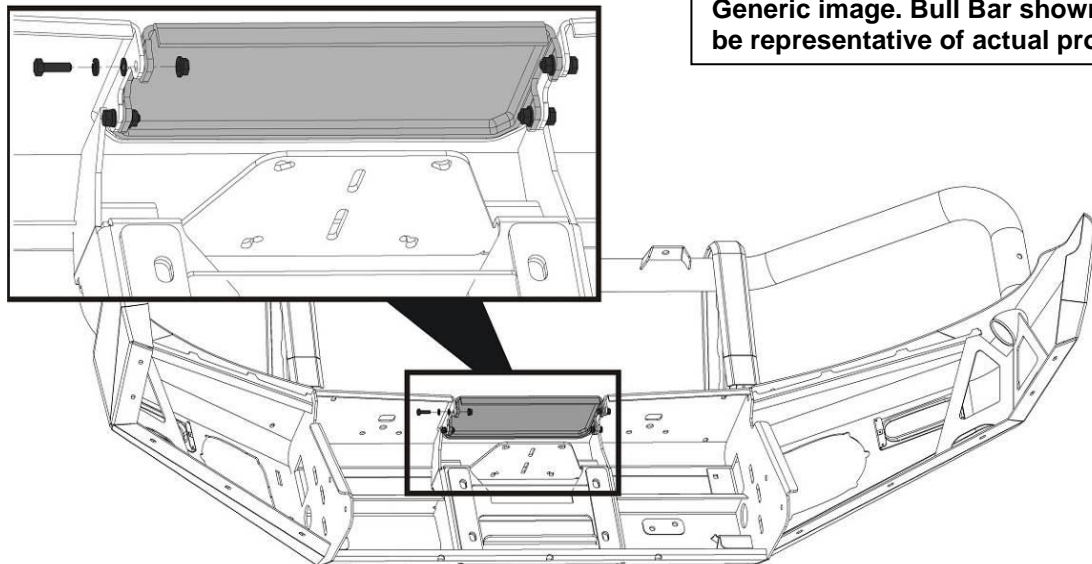

Note: If fitting a winch proceed using fitting instructions 3789337 supplied with 3501000 winch install kit. Once the winch is fitted, please continue to step 52. If no winch is being fitted continue from step 49.

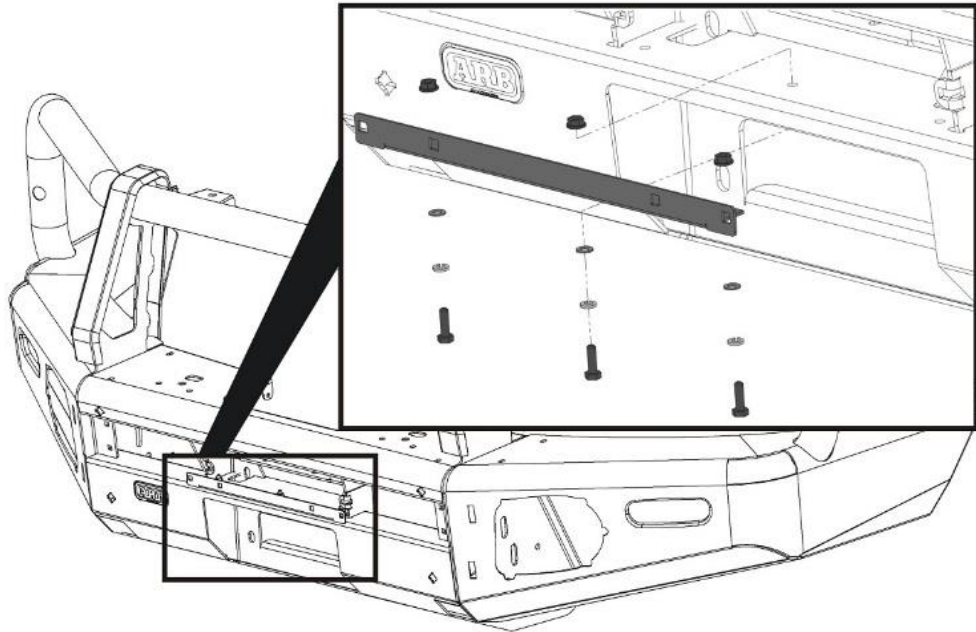
49. Slide the winch cover panel from the bottom up until it is level with the top face of the bar.
50. Fit the winch cover panel to the bar using 4 x M6 x 25 hex bolts, flat washers and nyloc nuts.

Warning: Be careful not to scratch the finish of the winch cover panel.



51. Fit the number plate bracket to the top face of the lower-centre pan on the bar using 3 x M6 x 25 hex bolts, flat washers and flange nuts.

Note: If you are fitting a winch, fit the folding number plate bracket supplied in winch install kit “3501000 SUMMIT BAR WINCH INSTALL KIT” – See fitting instructions 3789337



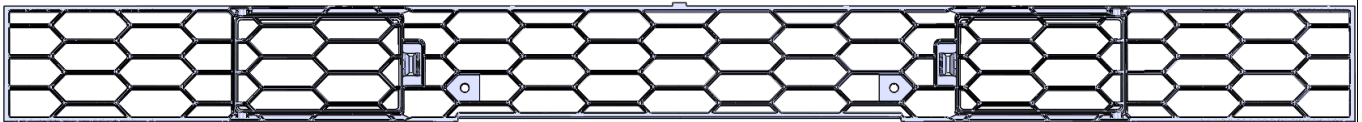
Note: The following steps show the fitment of the plastic moulded parts. The mouldings are supplied in kits along with all fasteners required for fitment. It is important that the fasteners supplied with each kit are only used for the mouldings from the same kit.

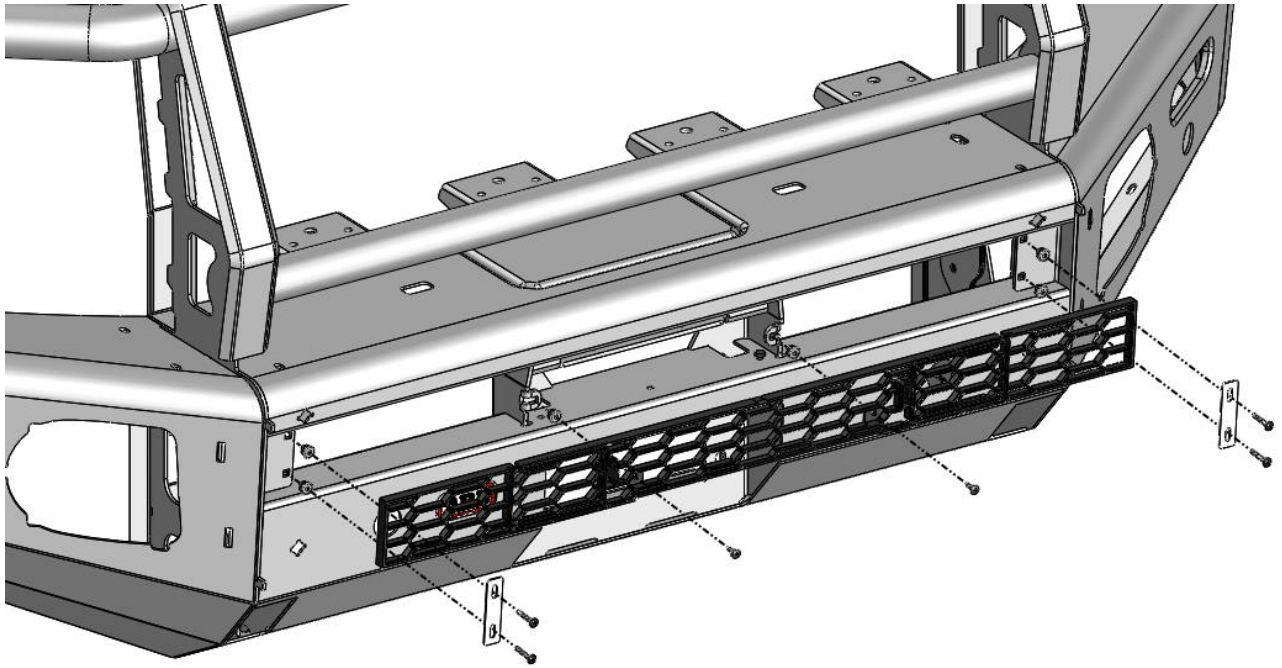
53. For this fitment the grille panel **DOES NOT** need cutting. Please install as-is.



54. Insert the 6 x plastic grommets into the 6 square holes in the front face of the bar.

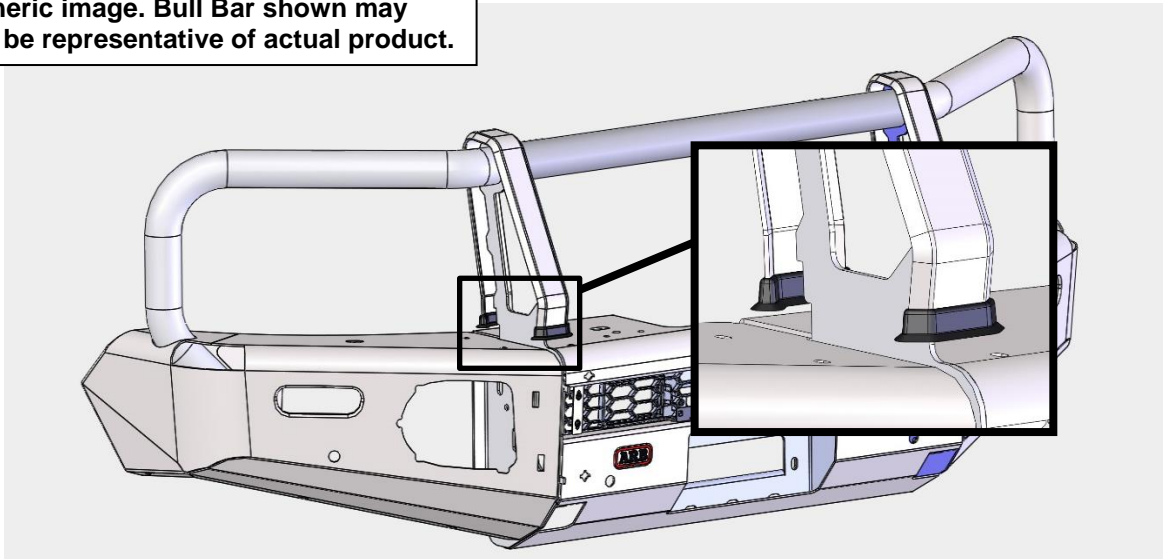
55. Insert the grille into the bar so that the hatches open outward (facing the front of the bar).

56. Attach the grille to the centre of the bar using the short screws into the grommets fitted above.
57. Attach the ends of the grille to the bar using the longer screws, through the clamp plates into the remaining grommets.



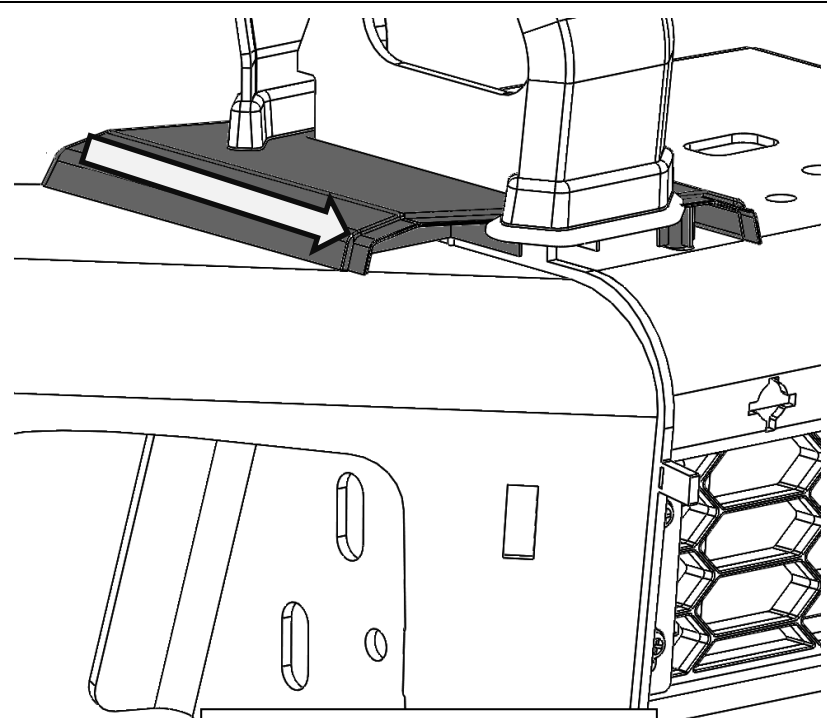
58. Fit the rubber intersection mouldings to the base of each upright cover strap.

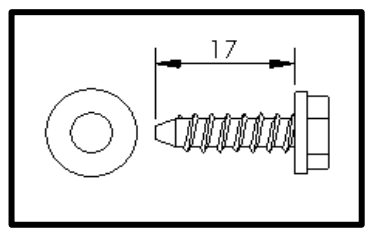


59. From the rear of the bar, slide the rear buffer sections under the rubber mouldings.
Fit 4 x screws and washers. Do not tighten screws. Leave enough play in buffers for adjustment later.
Note: Ensure that the skirts of the rubber intersection mouldings are not folded back on themselves and are sitting flat against the buffers.

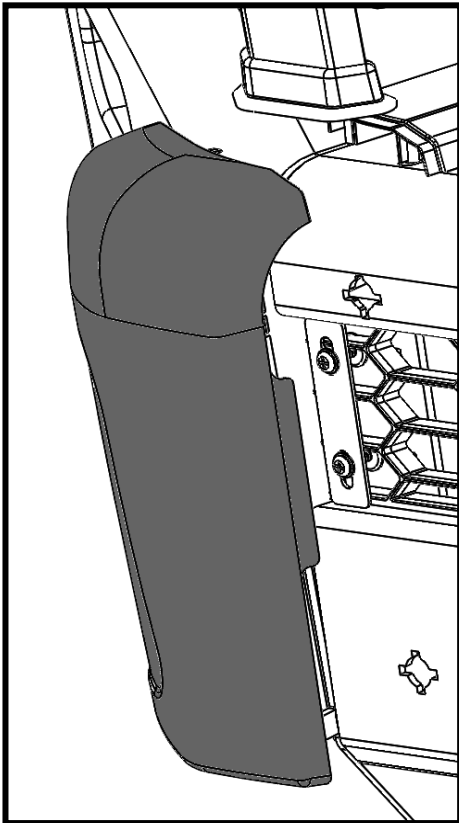


60. By aligning the front buffer with the tongue of the rear buffer, attach the front buffers to the front face of the bar. Ensure each buffer sits flat against the face of bar and is keyed into the top section of the rear buffer.

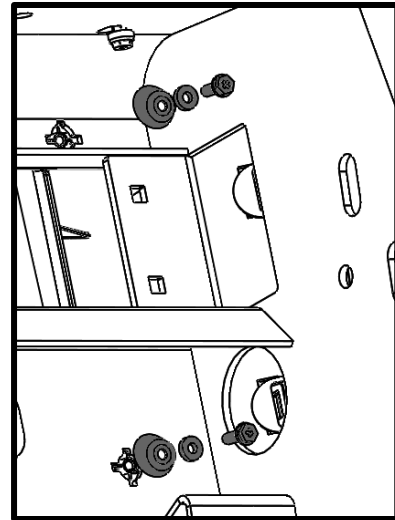
Secure wing side using retaining clips.

Secure inner side using the angled cup washers, flat washers and screws.

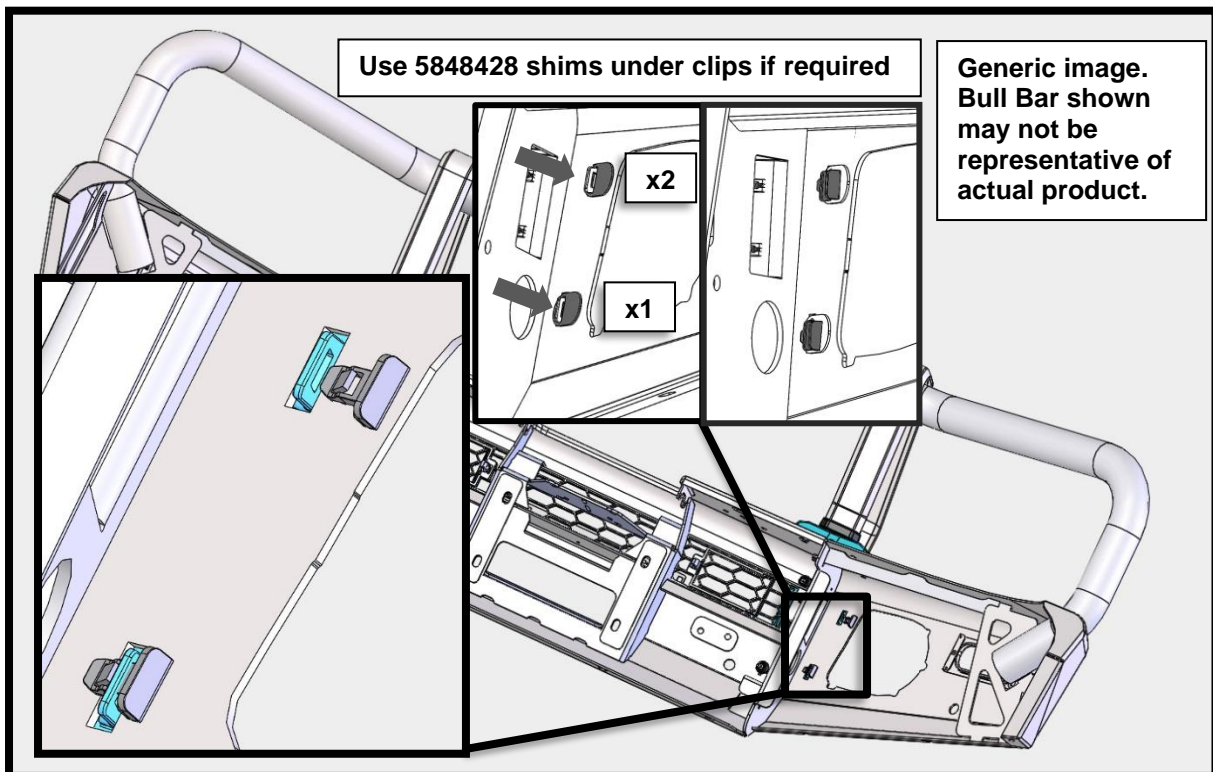
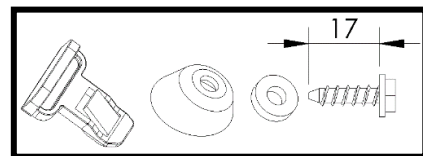

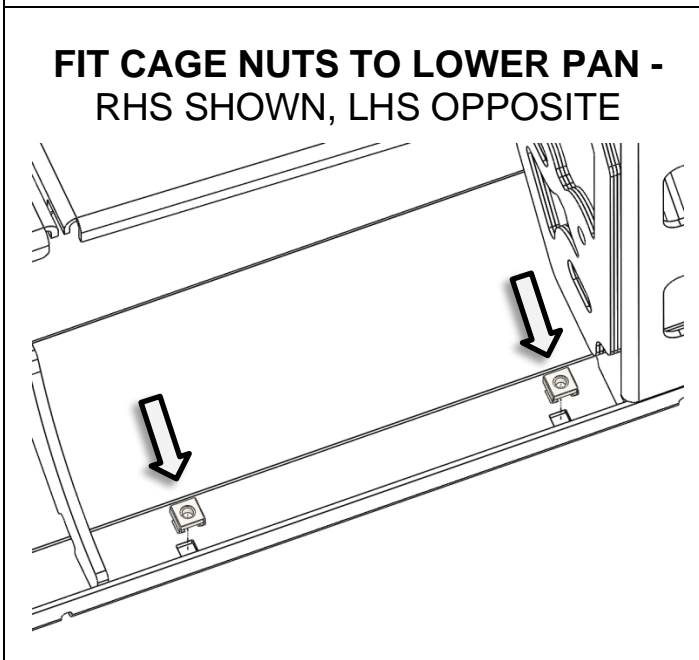
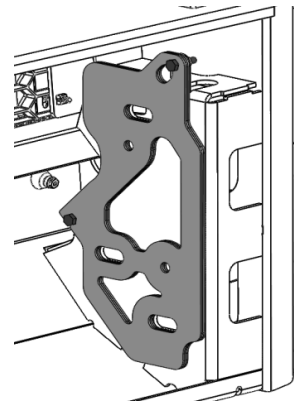
61. Fit the small plastic (square) grommets to the bar and attach the combination LED lamps to the bar using the Phillips head screws and M6 nuts and washers provided with the lamp kit.



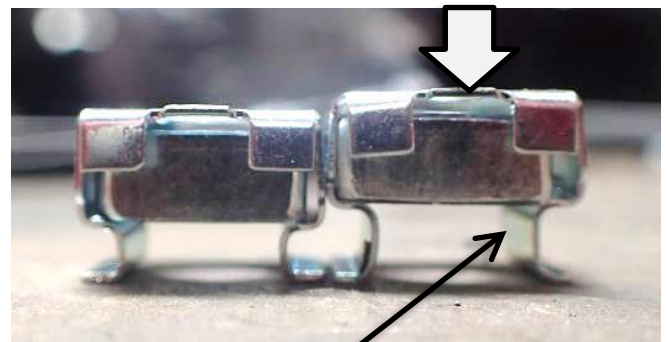
62. Fit an equal number of 2mm packers to the inside of the RH and LH bullbar uprights as required using M6 hardware provided. (Maximum of 3 per side shown at left)

The total clearance between the bull-bar mounting faces and the mounts should be roughly 1 - 2mm.

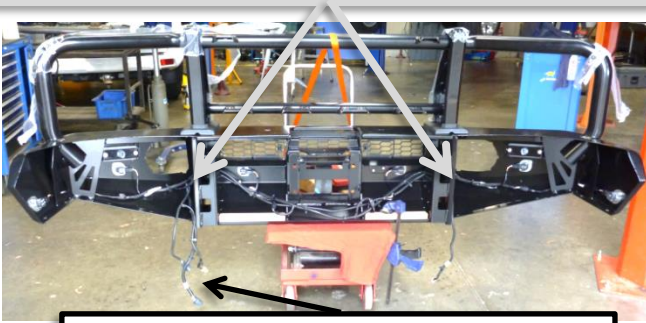


63. Fit the 4 longer leg M6 cage nuts to the lower pan of the bull bar as shown.

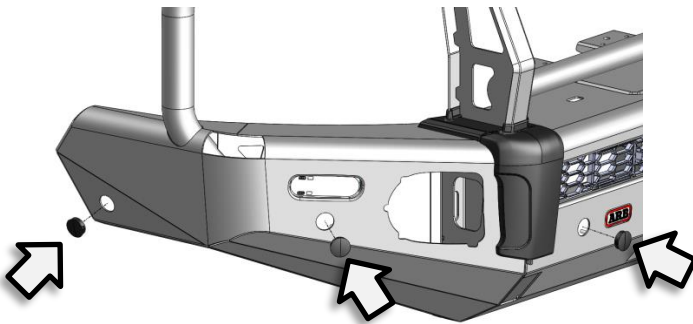

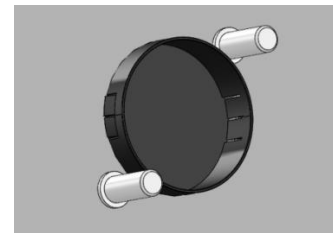
64. Fit the lamp harness removed from the bumper to the bull bar prior to assembling to vehicle.
65. Route the outboard harness leads through the large holes in the uprights, positioning the vehicle connector on the left.
66. Secure all looms to bar using cable ties provided.

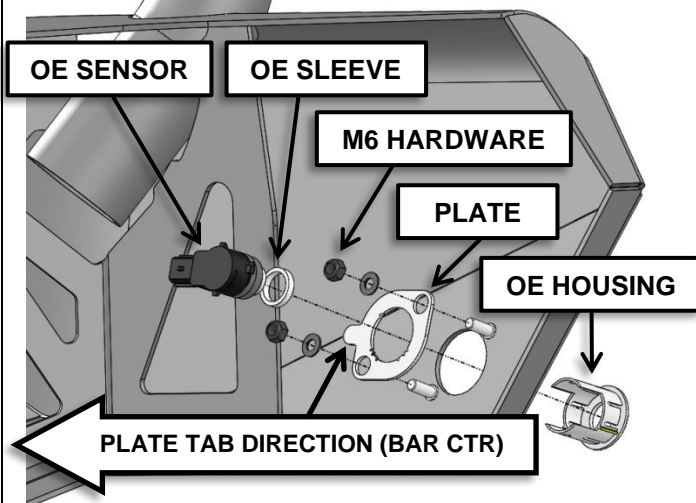


67. **Non-Sensor models:** (eg Express) Locate and install the six (6) sensor hole blanking plugs provided in the kit to the front of the bar.

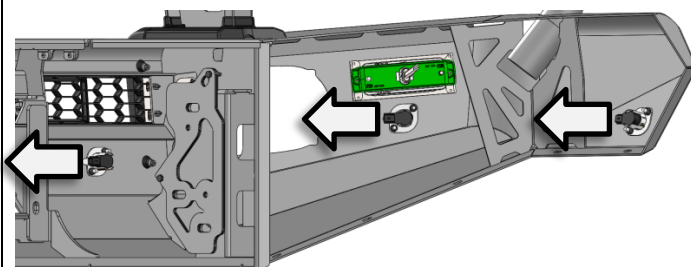

68. Extend ALL six (6) sensor leads by connecting the 6x 350mm long extension cables provided to the OE sensor plugs.

69. Locate the 6x OE FPA sensors, Silicone sleeves and housings removed earlier then carefully assemble to bar in this sequence; a) 6x sensor clamp plates to bar using M6 hardware provided (*with orientation tabs on ALL plates pointing towards centre of bull bar*) ensuring that they sit flat against the rear face of the bar avoiding the welded stud heads, b) 12x M6 washers and c) 12x M6 Nyloc nuts. Then assemble the 6x OE housings into the front of bar until centred in the bar opening and seated securely in the sensor mount plates. Finally install the OE FPA sensors with OE Silicone sleeves into the OE housings from the rear of the bar until securely seated in the OE housings.

CAUTION: Ensure that the OE sensors and matched OE housings are assembled in the corresponding location and orientation as removed from the OE bumper earlier.

70. Secure loom with cable ties provided.

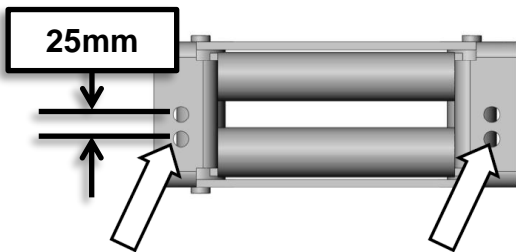

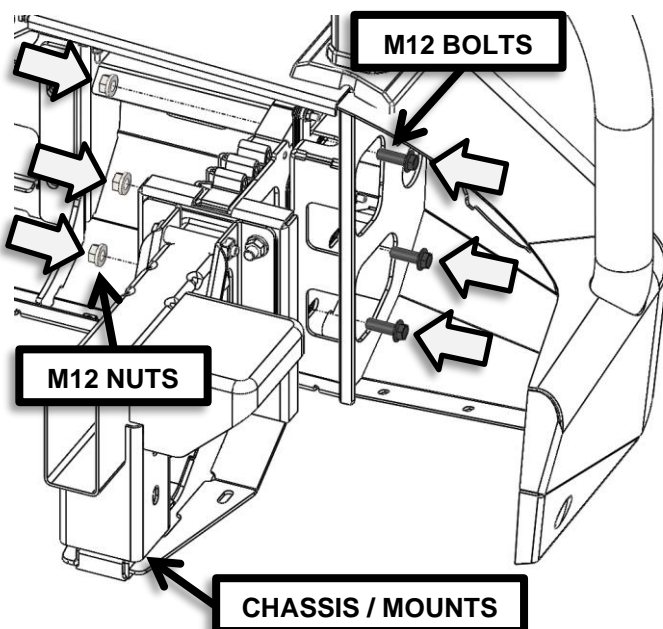
Install Bar on Vehicle

71. Apply some low tack film around the Bar and/or vehicle to protect the Bar and vehicle during alignment and assembly.
72. With the assistance of another person, place the bar on the elevating trolley.
73. Ensure all other aftermarket accessories such as driving lights/winch/UHF aerial have been fitted to the bull bar.

WARNING: *Due to the weight of the bar and winch if fitted, it is advised that you use some form of mechanical assistance when lifting the bar onto the vehicle such as an elevating trolley.*

NOTE: Winch Roller Fairlead must be drilled to 25mm offset if not already done so.

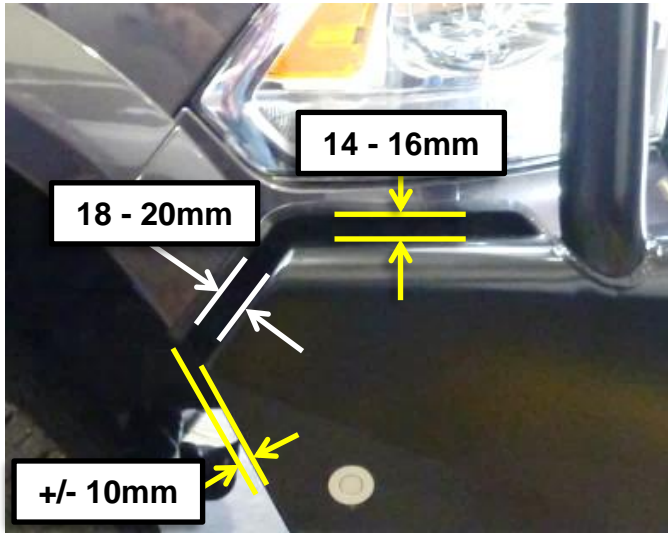

74. With the aid of another person, carefully lift and align the bar with the chassis mounts on the vehicle then position and loosely bolt the bull bar to the mounts using 6 x Hex Head Flange Bolts M12x1.25x35 PC8.8 BTZP and 6x M12x1.25 PC8 TZP flange nuts.

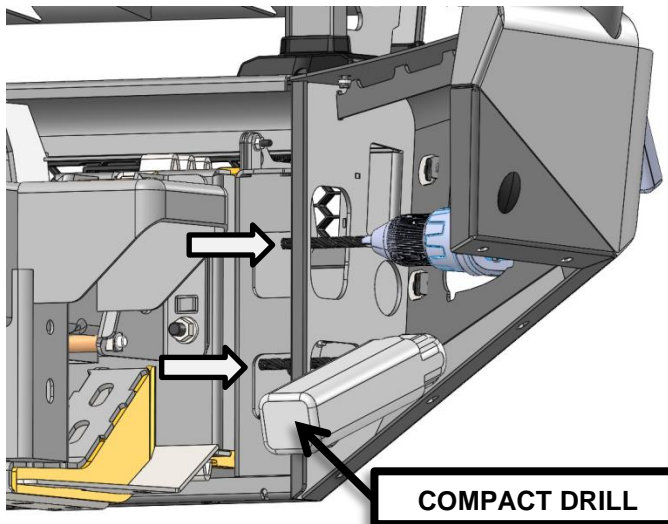
75. Adjust position of Bar such that;
 - a. It is level with trimmed Bumper profile
 - b. There is even gapping all around as shown at left
 - c. There is a minimum of 10mm clearance between Bar (&/or fitted accessories eg Winch Control Box...) at the front of the vehicle
 - d. CB Aerial / Brackets are either vertical or leaning slightly rearward
76. Once Bar is visually in correct position, tighten 6 x Hex Head Flange Bolts M12x1.25x35 PC8.8 BTZP connecting Bull Bar to Mounts.



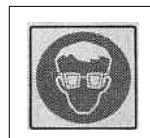

77. Once satisfied with the position of the bar on the vehicle drill the two Ø10mm pinning bolt holes per side through the upright mounts with a 10mm drill bit. The upper set of holes can be drilled with a regular power drill through the fog light openings, while the lower set require a compact power drill as indicated.
78. Apply some anti-corrosion touch up paint to the drilled areas.

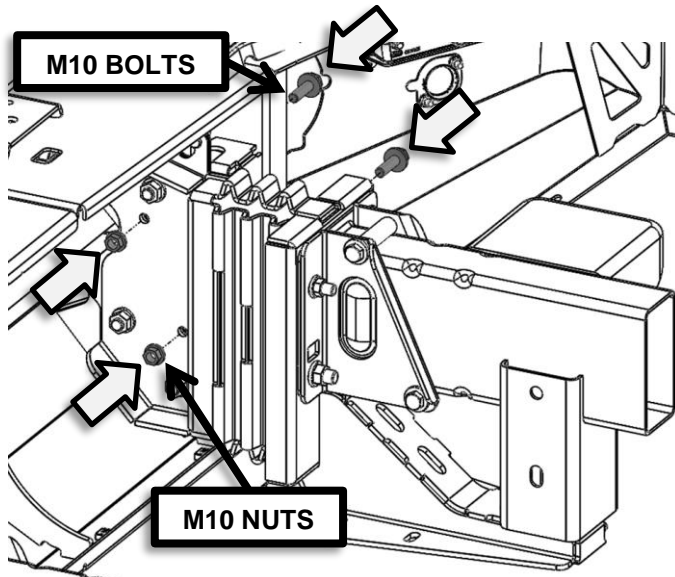

79. Measure the clearance between the RH vehicle fender and the RH bull-bar wing. Repeat on the LH side to confirm that the bar is sitting centrally on the vehicle.
80. If not, remove the bar from its mounts and shift the required number of 2mm packers installed on the bull-bar mounts from one side to the other. Next re-fit the bar on the mounts lining up the Ø10mm holes drilled in previous steps.

81. Once satisfied with the fitment of the bar to the vehicle, fit the 4x M10 x 40 SEMS bolts and 4x M10 flange nuts to the RH & LH mounts (4 off - 2 per mount).

82. Assemble and install ARB Fog Light surrounds (P/No. 3163082) as per instructions P/No. 3789190 supplied with surround kit.

Note: Optional fog lamps shown can be installed at this point as per fitting instruction supplied with fog lamp kit no. 3500910

***HINT:** loosely fit top bracket to fog light surround, then insert into Bull bar aperture, top outside corner first.

83. If installing fog lights to non factory equipped vehicles, use ARB wiring loom 3500520.

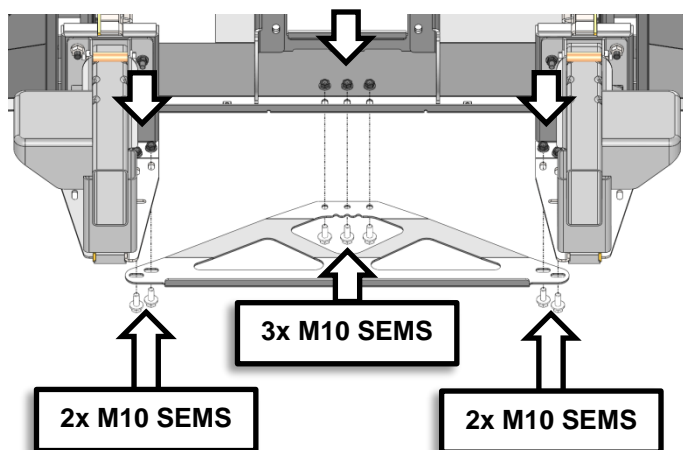


84. Connect all relevant looms to vehicle; Indicator, Fog and FPA Sensor (if present) and check operation.

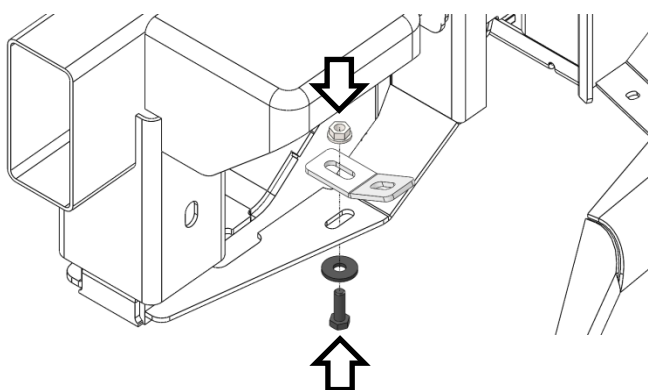

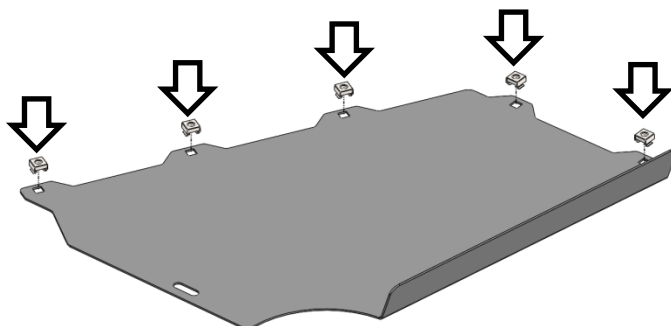

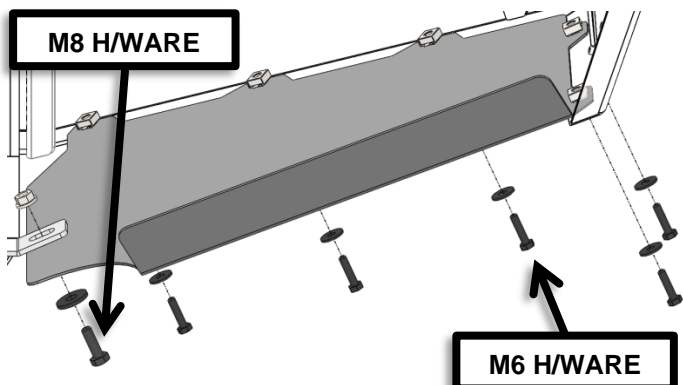

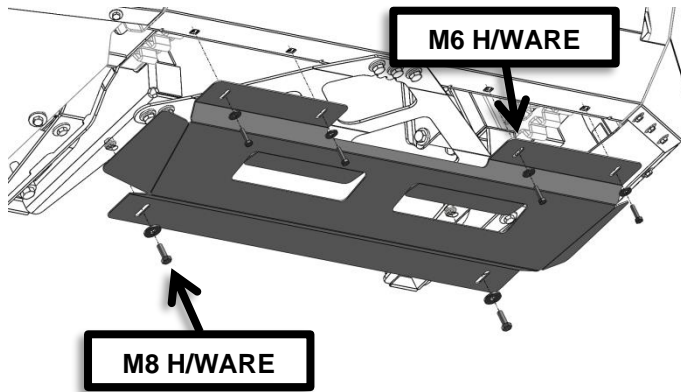
FIT WING UNDERPANELS TO BULL BAR RHS SHOWN – LHS OPPOSITE

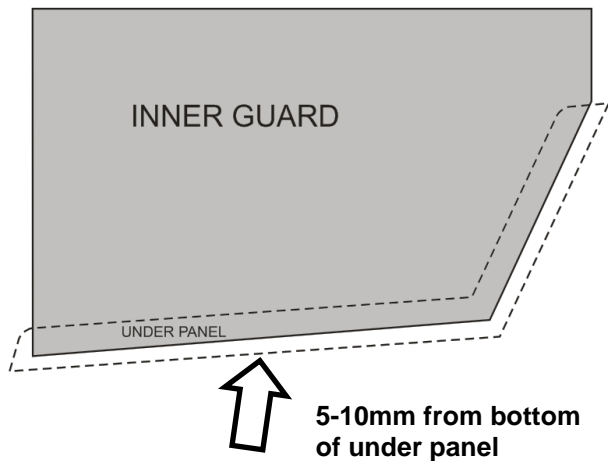


89. Secure stone guard to front/underside of bull bar using 4x M6 bolt and washer sets into 4x M6 cage nuts installed previously into lower pan.

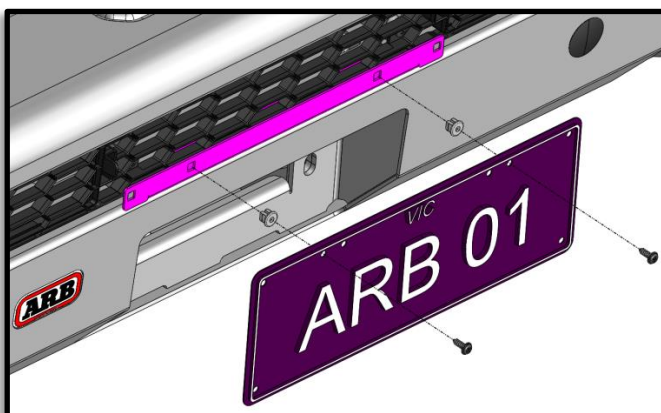

NOTICE: ONCE SUMMIT BAR IS FITTED:

- ◆ Ensure all bolts are tensioned correctly.
- ◆ All wiring is clear of sharp edges or moving surfaces and secured properly.
- ◆ Piping is secured well away from sharp or moving components.
- ◆ Check operation of winch, if fitted.
- ◆ Check all wiring and connections to turn signal lamps, sensors, headlamp washers etc. are functioning correctly.
