

## Fitting of this bar should be carried out by qualified persons only.

1.Jack the Vehicle and place on support stands.

2. Fit the Chassis plates,link pins,bolts and nuts as per the photo.(Use existing Bumper Bar mounting bolt/Tighten to Manufacturer spec) **Do not tighten links yet** 

Note position of the LH bracket in the photo and match the RH side.



Note: Supplied is 2 different length links. The short ones are for STD height vehicles whilst the longer are for raised Vehicles to give more off-road articulation

3. Fit the Sway Bar To the links on both sides,

4. Swing the bar up towards the Diff (hold the bar up with a stand of some sort).

## 5. Fit one side U/bolt, Diff plate D/bracket and D/bush to the bar and nip up the nuts6. Repeat on the other side



Note: the D/bush buts against the lock ring and in turn the U/bolt sits against the Brake hose brackets

7. Tighten the U/bolts and Links



Recheck positioning making sure the bar is central and clear of all obstacles. Torque all bolts before lowering the vehicle off the stands

Please drive carefully to get used to the new handling characteristics.
