## **Fitting Instructions #4824IS Toyota Fortuner Rear Panhard Rod Bushing** End attached to the differential End attached to the Chassis Jack the vehicle up and support on jack stands/hoist; 0 Remove the rear panhard rod; 0 With the use of a hydraulic press and suitable pressing tools, remove original bushes; 0 Using the grease supplied, lubricate the housing and the outside surface of the new 0 '4824' and '4828' bushes and push them in as shown in the figures; Crush Tube Generously lubricate the outside of the steel tube and inside of the bush, then push 0 the steel crush tube into the bush; Refit the panhard rod to the vehicle and tighten all bolts to manufacture's torque Press 0 settings. '4824' Bush *Note:* Polyurethane bushings must be fitted to both sides of the vehicle. Press '4828' Bush Panhard Rod to Chassis Panhard Rod to Differential '4828' Bush Press
