Fitting Instructions #4891IS

Mitsubishi Pajero NM, NP

Rear Upper Control Arm Inner Bushes

Note: Polyurethane bushings must be fitted to both sides of the vehicle.

- o Wheel-align the vehicle before the job is started and note settings;
- o With the vehicle on jack stands, remove the rear upper control arms;
- o Remove the original bushes including the steel shell;
- Apply the grease supplied to the control arm housing and the outside surface of the bush;




Figure 01 - Rear Upper Control Arm Bush Installation

- o Using the appropriate pressing tools, support the control arm and press the new '4891' and '4892' bushes into the arm housing. Note the <u>orientation of the bushes</u> to be pressed in the control arm housing, Figure 01;

Note: use a flat plate to cover all surface of the end of the bush to press the shell in the housing.

- o Apply the grease supplied to the bore of the bush and the outside surface of the steel crush tubes, then push the crush tubes in the bush;
- o Refit the rear upper control arms to the car and tighten the bolts to manufacture's torque settings;
- o Re-assembly the rest of the car and carry out a wheel alignment.

Important:

- '4891' bush is fitted to the front eye, with the larger diameter, wide flange and metal shell positioned toward the front.
- '4892' bush is fitted to the rear eye, with the large diameter, narrow flange and metal shell positioned towards the rear.
