Note: The O.E. bushes can be removed without the rack having to be removed;

- o Jack the vehicle up;
- o Remove the bush bracket bolts. Lift the rack about 10mm just to give enough clearance, then remove the OE bushes and clean the surface before fitting the new SuperPro ones;
- o Install the new SuperPro Bushes and then re-install the OE brackets;
- o Tighten all bolts according to the General Torque Specification Table or to manufacture's specifications.
