
## Fitting Instructions #5495IS

## Toyota Landcruiser 300 Series FRONT UPPER CONTROL ARM INNER BUSH



**Note:** Fitting instructions apply to both sides of the car. SuperPro bushes must be fitted to both sides of the vehicle.

- o Complete a wheel alignment on the vehicle before starting the job and note the settings.
- o Raise the vehicle using a hoist or jack stands and remove the upper control arm.
- o Remove the original bushes including the shell from the front upper control arms with the use of an air chisel and suitable pressing tools. Alternatively, use an Oxy-acetylene torch to remove the rubber then, cut the factory shell and chisel it out.
- o Clean housing and remove any remaining bushing material from the inside of the control arm.
- o Use appropriate pressing tools to press in the new bushings.
  - o Note: Bushings must be pressed in with the shell side of the bushing facing outwards from the control arm as shown.
  - O Note: Press bushings until the metal flange contacts the control arm.
- Apply grease to the inside of the bushing and the outside of the crush tube then press into the bush
  - o Note: For 5495XK (offset version) orientate the crush tube for desired camber with reference to table 1 below.
  - o For a lifted vehicle it is suggested that negative camber be increased.
- O Lubricate the mounting faces of the bushings and the points on the chassis where the bushing contacts, then reinstall the control arm to the chassis.
- o Ensure all fasteners are torqued to manufacturers specification and carry out a wheel alignment.
- o Recheck all bolts after 1 month or 100kms.




Table 1: Illustration of Camber settings
