## **Daihatsu Charade**

## Front Lower Control Arm Rear Bushing



Note: Polyurethane bushes must be fitted to both sides of the vehicle.

- o Jack the vehicle up and support on jack stands/hoist and remove the front wheels;
- o Remove:
  - The brake hose mounting bracket clip;
  - The hose from bracket;
  - The two strut mount bolts and separate bottom of strut from hub;
  - The two upper strut mount nuts;
  - The front strut assembly from the vehicle;
  - The strut rod retaining nut by using a suitable spring compressor. Note: this is a dangerous task and should only be performed by trained people.
- o Drill out the spot welds with a Ø5 or Ø6mm drill, Figure 1;




Figure 2 - Bush installation

- o Separate the upper part of the strut top from the bottom washer, Figure 2;
- o Remove the original rubber bush and any left material;
- o Apply the grease supplied onto all contact surfaces of the bush;
- o Install the new bushing, Figure 2 and Figure 3;
- o Re-fit the strut mount assembly and coil spring to the strut;
- o Re-assemble all components back to the vehicle;
- o Carry out wheel alignment.
- o All mounting bolts are to be torque to manufacture's specifications with the vehicle at ride height.
