

Fitting Instructions #5392IS

Jeep Grand Cherokee WK, WK2 (2011-On)
Rear Subframe Bushes

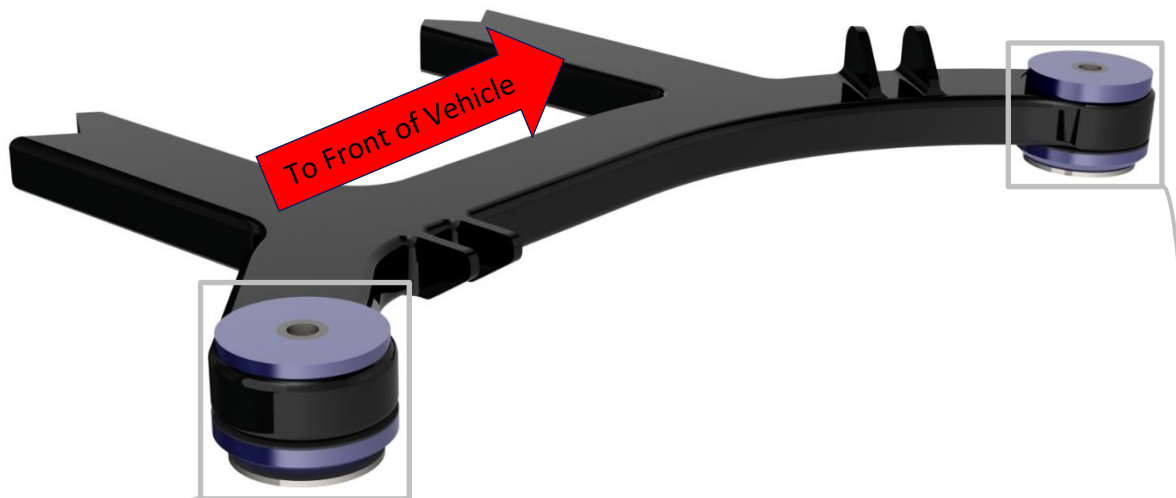
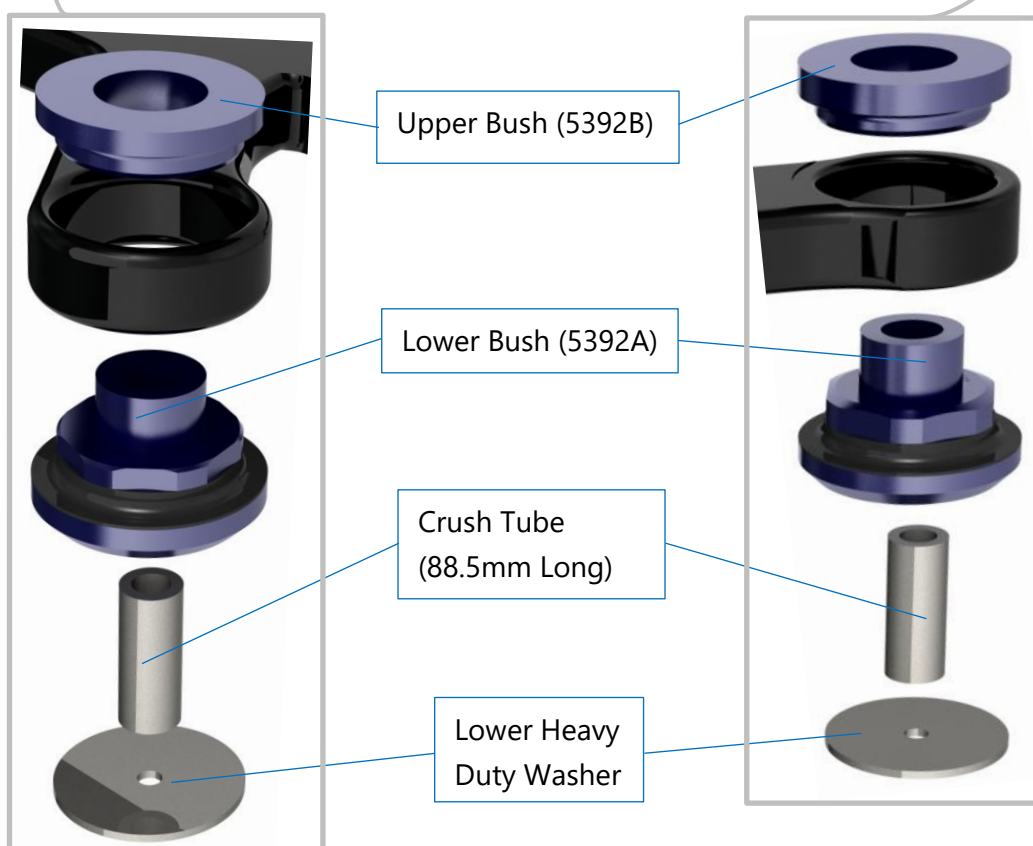


Figure 1: New SuperPro Bushes Position in Sub Frame



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Note: Polyurethane bushes must be fitted to both sides of the vehicle.

- Jack vehicle up and put on stands/hoist, remove rear wheels, exhaust and disconnect the hand brake cable.
- Support the subframe with a long adjustable stand or similar, then remove the rear sub frame bolts.
- Lower the rear subframe until you have enough clearance (approx. 30mm) to place a pressing plate on top (around 95mm OD plate) for use to remove factory bushes. *Note: careful to not stretch any cable.*

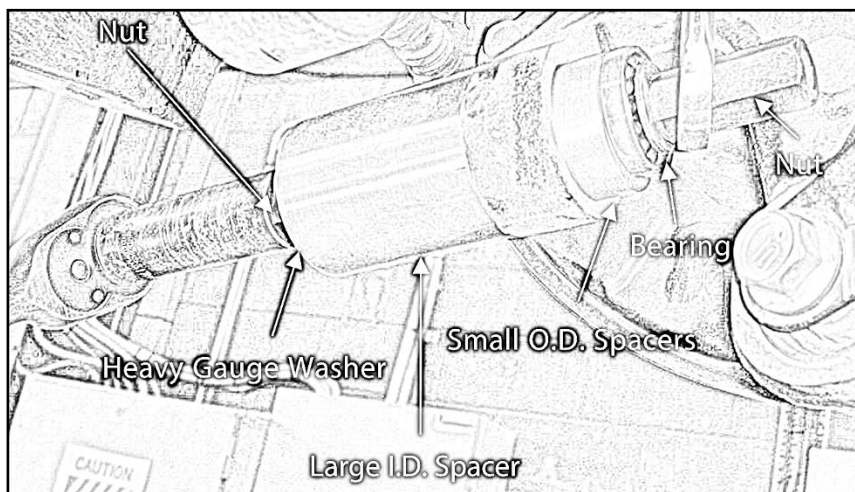


Figure 2: Press Tool Setup (Illustrative Purpose)

- Setup press tool assembly to extract the factory bushes (refer Figure 2 below for example).
- Clean housing areas to remove any old original bushing materials.
- Apply grease supplied onto the housing and install the new polyurethane bushings according to Figure 1 above.
- Apply grease to the bore of the bushes, and outside of steel crush tube, then press the crush tube in.
- Refit the sub frame to the vehicle in reverse order, ensuring that you use manufactures torque settings and carry out a wheel alignment.
