Step-By-Step Instructions

1. Remove tail lights from vehicle. 2x Screws per light.
2. Remove rear bumper
 - a. Remove rubber stop from inside boot area each side. 2x M5 each side.
 - b. Remove additional M5 bolts from inside boot area. 2x each side.
 - c. Remove screws and scrivets from wheel archs. 5x in total each side.
 - d. Remove Scrivets from under bumper. 2x in total.
 - e. Carefully remove bumper from vehicle. Use two people if required.
3. Remove and discard impact beam. 6x Bolts in total
4. Remove and discard shipping hook. 3x M10 bolts
5. Lower the exhaust. 2x Rubber hangers
6. Position towbar in place on vehicle.
7. Loosely attach all fasteners to vehicle.
 - a. 4x M10 long bolts with flat washer, spring washer and nuts.
 - b. 4x M10 short bolts with flat washer and spring washer into captive nuts.
8. Tighten all bolts to correct torque specifications.
9. Refit exhaust on rubbers.
10. Bumper cut **may** be required on some models. Check before refitting bumper.
11. Refit bumper and taillights in the reverse order as above.
