Instructions Rear Upper Control Arm Bushings

This instruction sheet should be used in conjunction with the workshop manual and proper safety procedures followed.

• Raise vehicle evenly and safely support.

Never rely on a Jack only

- Proceed to remove rear wheels and un-bolt upper arms. Refer images.
- Using a Press, press out old bushings including steel outer shell. Alternatively, drill hole in rubber and cut a slit in outer steel shell.
- Using a Press and soapy water, press in new supplied bushings. Press with flat surfaces.

Note - press bushing 92016 into front eye and 92017 into rear eye.

- · Grease bushing ID and face with supplied grease
- Push in supplied steel tubes.

• Re-fit arm to vehicle - re-check all bolts after 100kms
