FITTING INSTRUCTIONS

Strut Bar to Chassis Bushes Suits- Ford Falcon, Fairlane-XP-XF/XG Models exc XC

N.B: These instructions should be used in conjunction with workshop manual.

- 1. Raise the front of vehicle and support with chassis stands, remove the front wheels from the vehicle.
- 2. Remove the front nut, washer and bushes from the front of strut rod.
- 3. Remove the nuts from the strut rod to lower control arm, and remove the strut rod and rear strut rod bush.
- 4. Clean and inspect the strut rod, washers and chassis bracket for rust, paint, damage, pitting and old rubber deposits and clean or replace as necessary.
- 5. Fit the new replacement bushes to the vehicle ensuring that the **FA69A** (male bush) marked **front** is fitted in the front most position, and the **FA70A** (female bush) is fitted to the rear position (refer to image below).
- 6. Lubricate the internal bore flange and thrust faces of the bushes with the grease supplied and fit the metal crush tubes to the bushes.
- 7. Refit the strut bars to the vehicle and tighten all nuts to manufacturers specifications.



N.B: It is recommended that a licenced workshop or trades person carry out the above procedure and that workshop manual and relevant safety procedures are followed in addition to the above.
