- Raise vehicle evenly and safely support. *Never rely on a jack only*
- Proceed to disconnect upper control arm ball joint. Complete removal of the arm may be necessary to remove the strut.
- Next, un-bolt complete strut from vehicle. Note orientation of the 3 studs verse the wheel . This will help with re-fitting strut to vehicle. Note below LH image.
- Compress the spring to remove the upper top. Fit up new top with new shock bushings and spring pad. Re-use OE upper shock nut.



It is recommended that a licenced workshop or trades person carry out the above procedure and that workshop manual and relevant safety procedures are followed in addition to the above.
