## Instruction Sheet Front Control Arm - Rear Bushings

N.B: This instruction sheet should be used in conjunction with the workshop manual

**Application** - Toyota Landcruiser - 100 Series

1. Raise vehicle evenly and safely support.

(Always refer current catalogue for complete listings

Never rely on a Jack only


2. Proceed to remove front wheels. Unbolt control arms from vehicle.


Contents - Bushing 90835 x2

- Bushing 90836 x2
- Steel tube 30x18.4x90 x2
- Grease

Note - the rear bushing is located in the chassis. To remove, this will require cutting or chiselling out.

- 3. Push new supplied bushings into clean chassis eye. Refer diagram below.
- 4. Grease bushing internal diameter and side faces with supplied grease only.
- 5. Push in supplied steel tubes.
- 6. Re-install arm to vehicle, tighten bolts as per manufacturer spec.
- 7. A wheel alignment will be required after install.
- 8. Re-check all bolts after 100-500kms





N.B: It is recommended that a licences workshop or tradesperson carry out tha above procedure and that workshop manual and relevant safety procedures are followed in addition to the above.
