



Differential Positive Power Kit

N.B: This installation guide should be used in conjunction with the workshop manual.



Bush removal is best achieved with the use of an air hacksaw. Cut down through the rubber voiding and steel shell being careful not to damage the subframe housing.

Install the 67167 bush into the subframe housing so that the orientation of the voiding faces upward and downward. Apply a light smear of grease to the inside of the subframe housing.
