
## - Step 1



Always refer to the vehicle's Workshop Manual when removing vehicle components.

- Note down all clock and radio settings.
- In the engine bay, disconnect the negative battery terminal (1).
- Inside the luggage compartment, remove the sun shade.




## - Step 2

### Note: This step is only required for 5 door models

- On the third row seat cover, remove the luggage anchors and fasteners (1).
- Remove the third row seat cover (2).




#### - Step 3

#### Note: This step is only required for 5 door models

- Remove the third row seat bracket fasteners (1) and the third row bracket (2).
- Remove the bolts at the front and rear of the LHS third row seat (3)
- Dislodge the LHS third row seat (3).
- Remove the rear trim (4).

Always refer to workshop manual for assistance with part removal.






# - Step 4

Note: This step is only required for 3 Door models.


• In the luggage compartment area, remove the indicated fasteners (1) from the rear trim (2) and then remove the rear trim (2).


## - Step 5 -

- Remove the LHS rear passenger door sill trim (1) by removing its fastener (2).
- Remove the LHS rear passenger seat belt cap (3) and remove the bolt (4) from underneath.



### - Step 6


- In the luggage compartment, remove the LHS trim jack door (1) (applies only to 5-door models).
- Shift the LHS third row seat (2) out of the way.
- Remove the LHS floor carpet (3).
- Remove the two fastener caps (4).
- Remove the luggage compartment trim handle (5) and its fasteners (6).
- Remove the remaining fasteners (7) from the vehicle.
- Remove the LHS luggage compartment trim (8).





# - Step 7 -

• Remove the indicated grommet (1) from the LHS rear quarter.




### - Step 8 -

#### Grommet position from underneath the vehicle

• From underneath the vehicle, feed the Trailer Harness (1) through two holes into the previously removed grommet location in the luggage compartment.

 Ensure the Trailer Harness grommets (2) are seated correctly in the two holes.




# - Step 9

- Retrieve the Trailer Harness (2) into the luggage compartment.
- Free the break-out connector (1).
- Connect the Trailer Harness connector (2) to the vehicle break out connector (1).
- Using a supplied Cleaning Pad, clean the area in the LHS tail light cavity, where the ECU will be mounted (3).



If the vehicle is fitted or being fitted with a Reverse Parking Assistance Kit (2), discard the RPA Patch Harness and use the Trailer Harness Patch Harness instead.






### Step 10 -

- Connect the Trailer Harness ECU connector (1) to the ECU (2).
- Using the supplied Cleaning Pad, clean the back of the ECU (2).




Allow the area cleaned with the supplied Cleaning Pad to dry before continuing.

- Adhere the Double Sided Tape (3) onto the ECU (2).
- Peel off the adhesive backing from the ECU (2) and mount onto the vehicle mounting location in the LHS tail light cavity.
- Ensure the ECU is mounted with the connector facing downwards as shown.




## - Step 11 -

• Route the Trailer Harness ring terminal (1) on to the vehicle grounding point (2) using the existing fastener (3).



# - Step 12

- Route the Trailer Harness (1) towards the towbar mounting bracket (2).
- Secure the Trailer Harness (1) to the rear towbar with the two supplied 500mm Cable Ties (3) in the indicated positions.






### Step 13 -

#### This step for 7 Pin Flat Socket:

- Secure the Trailer Socket (Flat Socket) (1) to the towbar mounting bracket (2)using the supplied M4 fasteners (3) as shown.
- Secure the Trailer Harness to the support bar (or towbar if fitted) using the supplied 300mm Cable Ties x2.




## - Step 14 -

#### This step for 7 Pin Large Round Socket:

- Secure the Protective Tape (1) to the bumper, behind the mounting plate
- Secure the Trailer Harness Socket (2) to the mounting bracket (3) using M5 fasteners (4).
- Secure the socket and bracket to the towbar mounting bracket (5) using the supplied M4 fasteners (6).

 Secure the Trailer Harness to the support bar (or towbar if fitted) using the supplied 300mm Cable Ties x2.






# - Step 15 -

#### This step for 7 Small Round Socket:

- Secure the Protective Tape (1) to the bumper behind the mounting plate.
- Secure the Trailer Harness Socket (2) to the mounting bracket (3) using M4 fasteners (4).
- Secure the socket and bracket to the towbar mounting bracket (5) using the supplied M4 fasteners (6).
- Secure the Trailer Harness to the support bar (or towbar if fitted) using the supplied 300mm Cable Ties x2.
- Test the operation of the Trailer Harness using test lights or a multimeter.







# - Step 16-

- Secure the Trailer Harness to the support bar (or towbar if fitted) using the supplied 300mm Cable Ties x2.
- Test the operation of the Trailer Harness using test lights or a multimeter.



Refit all removed parts and secure all fasteners to the Service Manual torque specifications.



Reprogram all radio stations and clock settings by referring to the vehicle's owner manual.
