Installation Guide

Rear differential - Rear OE mount - insert Suits: Falcon BF/Territory SY - with resin shell and ROUND CENTRE TUBE

(Always refer to the current catalogue for complete application listings)

N.B: This installation guide should be used in conjunction with the workshop manual

1. Raise the vehicle on 2 post hoist or raise rear of vehicle and place on chassis stands. Remove the rear wheels.

Falcon: From inside the vehicle remove the rear lower seat base and disconnect the left hand and right hand side rear ABS wheel speed sensor connections and pass the connectors through the floor.

Territory:

For single kit installation: Remove the spare wheel and carrier from the vehicle and proceed to SECTION A.

For Performance kit installation Falcon/Territory: Use Falcon instruction sheet.

- 2. Disconnect the left hand and right hand side rear ABS wheel speed sensor connections at the front of the rear lower trailing arm. From under the vehicle, remove the rear trailing arm front mount vertical retaining nuts.
- 3. Remove and support the rear disc brake callipers.
- **4.** Remove hand brake cables from hub backing plates or alternatively at the under floor adjuster plate above the prop shaft.
- **5.** Using a suitable marking pen, mark the location of the rear subframe to chassis and the position of the tail shaft to differential yoke for correct timing at re-installation.

NOTE: Location of rear subframe to chassis is critical:

The left hand differential outrigger retaining bolt and the rear of the fuel tank can make contact if the cross member is not refitted into the correct position. Support the rear subframe and remove all retaining nuts and bolts.

Note: please be aware of the single centre-retaining bolt mounted to the right hand side of the rear differential rear mount on some models.

6. Lower the subframe.

NOTE: Section A – installation of Enhancement kit = single kit Section A – instruction single enhancement kit

- 1. Remove the rear OE retaining bolt, OE washer and mass damper (if fitted).
- 2. Install supplied 67053 bush into the rear of the OE rear differential mount using a small amount of the grease supplied.
- 3. Grease the contact face of the large OD supplied washer and hold next to the insert.
- 4. Reinstall the OE retaining bolt, OE washer and mass damper (if fitted).

NOTE: Section B – installation of Performance kit = single kit x 2

Section B – instruction Performance kit = single kit x 2

- $\textbf{1.} \ \mathsf{Remove} \ \mathsf{the} \ \mathsf{rear} \ \mathsf{OE} \ \mathsf{retaining} \ \mathsf{bolt}, \ \mathsf{OE} \ \mathsf{washer} \ \mathsf{and} \ \mathsf{mass} \ \mathsf{damper} \ (\mathsf{if} \ \mathsf{fitted}).$
- 2. Remove the front outrigger inner retaining bolts, left and right hand side.
- **3.** Move the differential forward and install the supplied 67053 bush into the front of the OE rear differential mount using a small amount of the grease supplied.
- ${\bf 4.}$ Grease and install the supplied large OD washer into position against the differential nose.
- **5.** Install supplied 67053 bush into the rear of the OE rear differential mount using a small amount of the grease supplied.
- **6.** Grease the contact face of the large OD supplied washer and hold next to the insert.
- 7. Re-install the OE retaining bolt, OE washer and mass damper (if fitted).
- 8. Re-install the removed outrigger arm retaining bolts left and right hand side. NOTE: Tension all removed bolts and hardware to manufacturers specifications prior to refitting rear cross member as most of the components cannot be accessed with the cross member re-installed into the vehicle. Subframe Re-installation:

Repeat steps 1-8 in reverse.


Tension all removed bolts and hardware to manufacturers specifications.

NOTE: Location of rear subframe to chassis is critical:



NOTE: Timing of tail shaft to yoke is critical:


Please refer to previous markings made in step 6 during re-installation.
