Install Guide

Raise vehicle evenly and safely support.

Never rely on a Jack only

• Remove front wheels and proceed to un-bolt front control arms. It is suggested to remove and service one arm at a time.

- Bushing B2006 x4
- Steel tube 19x10x38 x4
- Steel tube 16x10x52 x2
- Grease

Note - a hydraulic Press will be required to replace bushings Do not remove the lower shock bushing unless purchased also


• Press out original bushings including steel outer shells.

Upper Arm


· Clean Eyes well from any grease or dirt.

Note - use soapy water and flat surfaces to push new bushings in.

- Grease bushings with supplied grease only.
- Use tube 38mm long for upper arm Use tube 52mm long for lower arm.
- Tighten original bolts to 50-60Nm
- a wheel alignment is recommended soon after install.
