Install Guide Front Control Arm -Lower Inner Rear Bushing

Raise vehicle evenly and safely support

Never rely on a Jack only


- Proceed to remove front wheels. Next, unbolt swaybar link, ball joint and bushing bolt and nut.
- · Remove control arms from vehicle.

Note - a hydraulic Press will be required to press out old bushing.


- Press out old bushings including the steel outer shell.
- Proceed to press in new bushing until flush with arm. For vehicles 2016-on - note bushing sits 10mm above arm Refer image below - to the right

IMPORTANT - bushing can only be pressed in one way Note - inner tube is offset - confirm larger ID is 'upwards'

- Re-fit arm to vehicle. Place supplied washer on top of bushing - refer image below.
- A wheel alignment is recommended after install - to correct any Toe change.
- Re-check all bolts after 100kms



Note - It is recommended that a licenced workshop or tradesperson carry out the below procedure and that workshop manual and relevant safety procedures are followed in addition to the above.


