

Installation Guide STEERING RACK BUSHINGS PAGE 1 of 1

N.B: This installation guide should be used in conjunction with the workshop manual.

Bill Of Materials:

- 4 x 68723 Synthetic Elastometer Bushings.
- 2 x 68724 Synthetic Elastometer Bushings.
- 2 x Steel tubes 60mm long
- 1 x Steel tubes 24mm long
- 1 x Grease satchet.
- 1 x Install guide.

Removal procedure:

- **1.** Disconnect the battery to prevent shorting out of electrical components.
- **2**. Raise the vehicle on the hoist or alternatively place on chassis stands.
- **3**. Remove the under trays from the vehicle.
- **4.** Supporting the cross member with a jack, remove the steering rack, lower cross member and rear engine mounting bolts.
- **5.** Disconnect the ball joints and remove the cross member from the vehicle.
- **6.** Using a suitable puller kit draw the OEM rubber bushings out of the rack mountings.
- **5.** Ensure the mounting bores are clean and free of burrs and fit the supplied bushings in the orientation shown in the images attached.
- **6.** Lubricate the bore and flange face of the bushings and install the supplied steel tubes.
- 7. Re install the vehicle cross member, torquing all bolts to manufactures specifications
- 8. Carry out wheel alignment
- 9. Re-torque all bolts in 60 Miles or 100 Km's.
