
INSTALLATION GUIDE

LOWER TRAILING ARM – FRONT

- 1. Support vehicle and differential, and remove lower trailing arms
- 2. Press old bushing from the trailing arm and inspect arm for any sign of wear, distortion or cracking. If arm is damaged, replace it.
- 3. Press new bushes into the trailing arm, taking care to support the arm around the eyes to prevent the arm from distorting.
- 4. Once installed , bushes should protrude equally from each side of the arm (refer diagram).

WARNING: Commodore trailing arms suffer from stretching of the eyelets, if;

- (a) A spacer is not used at installation. When replacing this bush, take care and fit a suitable spacer to prevent arm blades from collapsing.
- (b) The bush is pressed through the eye in the wrong direction (note the shell of the bush is tapered).
- 5. Lubricate end faces of bushes with grease provided before installing arms on vehicle, taking note to washers supplied.
- 6. Reassemble suspension as recommended in the workshop manual.
