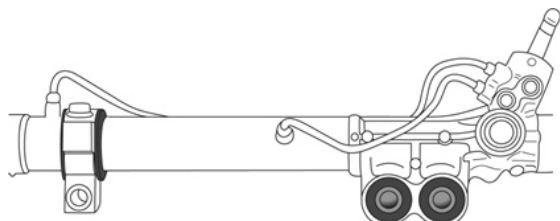


Instructions

Steering Rack Bushings

This instruction sheet should be used in conjunction with the workshop manual and proper safety procedures followed.



Application - Nissan D40
- R51 Pathfinder

Contents - 4x bushings 3028
1x bushing 3027
2x steel tubes 25x16x51
Grease

1. Raise vehicle evenly and safely support.

Note - it is possible to remove OE bushings with rack still hanging in vehicle.

2. Proceed to disconnect the battery and remove the front wheels.

3. Remove the plastic under-covers.

4. Un-bolt the 2 main bolts on drivers side, followed by the 1 passenger nut holding rack to frame. Also disconnect ball joints from hub

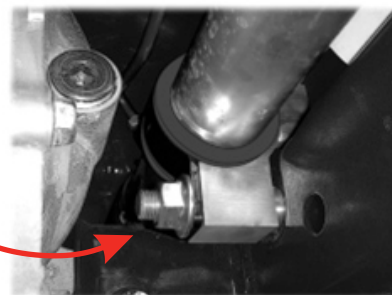
5. The OE bushings do not have a steel outer shell - so they can be pulled out with a suitable nut and bolt and large socket/ steel cup.

6. Once OE bushings removed, push in new supplied bushings 3028 into clean rack holes. Apply a small amount of grease to help with proper seating of bushing. Re-use original nuts and bolts.

7. Carry out a wheel alignment soon after install.

Old OE bushings can be pulled out with a suitable nut/bolt and socket whilst in vehicle.
