


#### INSTALLATION PROCEDURE FOR TOP LINK STRAPS




#### Prior to installing cargo barrier in vehicle -

1. Undo the nyloc nuts securing screws & straps in the top saddles.



- With the link strap (Item 3) inside saddle & the rear position top strap on top of saddle as shown, re insert the M10 screw then secure in place using nyloc nut removed earlier.
- 3. Tighten until straps are firm in/on saddle but can still be pivoted.
- 4. Repeat procedure on other side.

#### INSTALLATION PROCEDURE FOR BOTTOM FRONT POSITION STRAPS



- 5. Undo the nyloc nuts securing screws in the bottom saddles. *No need to remove screw.*
- With the correct front position strap on the correct side (Item 1 LHS—Item 2 RHS) place strap over screw as shown.
- Replace nyloc nut then tighten until straps are firm in/on saddle but can still be pivoted.
- 8. Repeat on other side.
- 9. If not required immediately secure the long bottom straps across the cargo barrier mesh using velcro ties (Item 6).

#### **INSTALLATION OF OTHER ITEMS**

- If not required immediately secure the tube extension straps (Item 4) across the cargo barrier using velcro ties (Item 6).
- Lateral support bracket (Item 7) can be attached to back of cargo barrier with Items 8 & 9 or put in glove box with Milbolts (Item 5).
