Fitting Instructions #4128XIS Nissan Patrol Y62 *Rear Control Arm Upper & Lower-Inner Bush Kit (Offset)*

Note: Polyurethane bushings must be fitted to both sides of the vehicle.

- o Wheel-align the vehicle before the job is started and note settings;
- o With the vehicle on jack stands, remove the control arms;
- o Remove the original bushes including the steel shell;
- Apply the grease supplied to the control arm housing and the outside surface of the bush;
- Using the appropriate pressing tools, support the control arm and press the new '4128' bushes in the arm housing. Note the <u>orientation of the bush</u> to be pressed in the control arm housing. <u>Refer to:</u> Figure 03 for the Rear Upper Control Arm bush kit installation; Figure 04 for the Rear Lower Control Arm bush kit installation.

Note: use a flat plate to cover all surface of the end of the bush to press the shell in the housing.

- Apply the grease supplied to the bore of the bush and the outside surface of the steel crush tubes, then push the crush tubes in the bush. Note: Tubes Must be pressed in correct orientation for appropriate alignment correction. Refer to Figure 01 & 02 for orientation of the crush tube in the bush.
- Refit the control arms to the car and tighten the bolts to manufacture's torque settings;
- Re-assemble the rest of the car and carry out a wheel alignment.
