Remove the A pillar grab handle. Pry off the two covers and undo using 10mm socket.



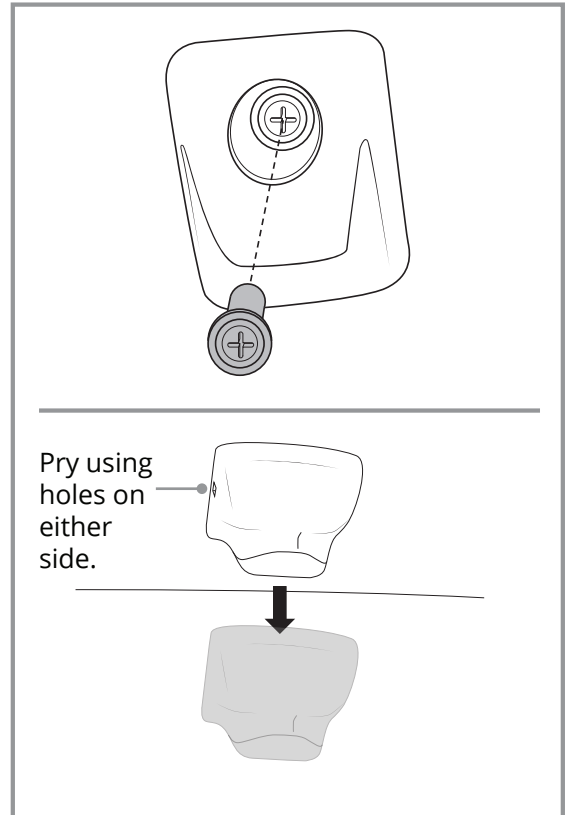
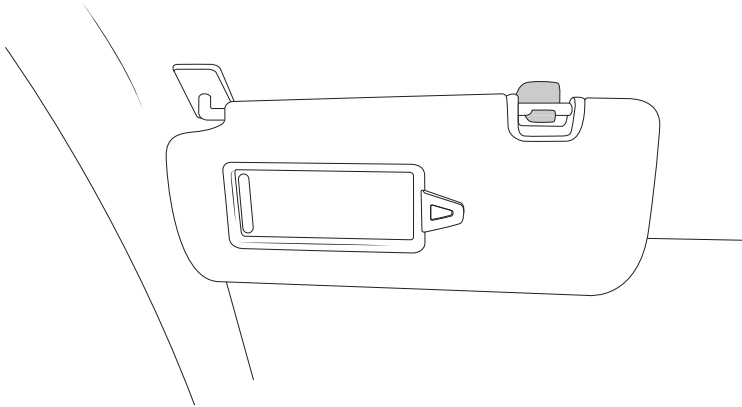

Remove the upper grab handle by prying off the covers and release two Phillips head screws.



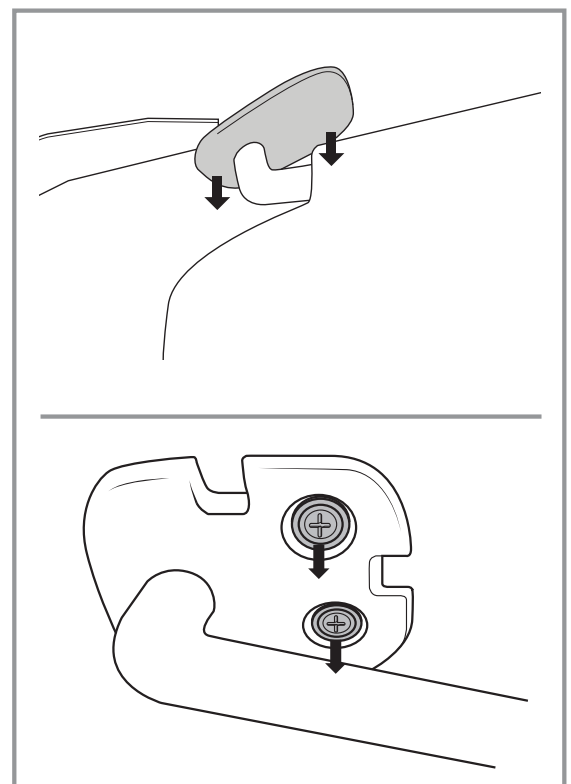
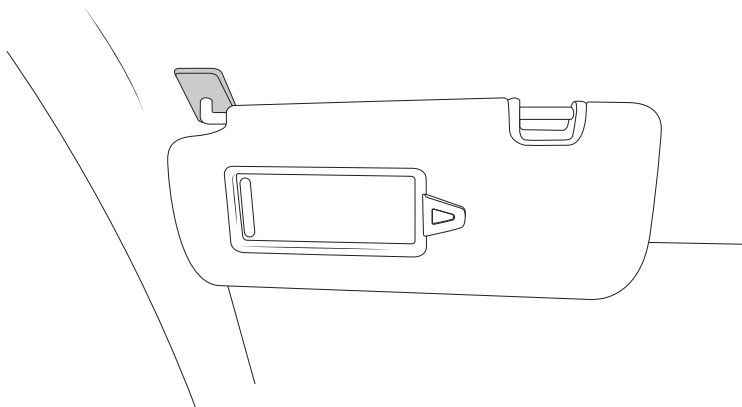

Gain access to the window visor, remove the sun visor bracket by releasing Phillips head screw, then by prying at the indicated holes on each side of the bracket. Pull down and the bracket will release.



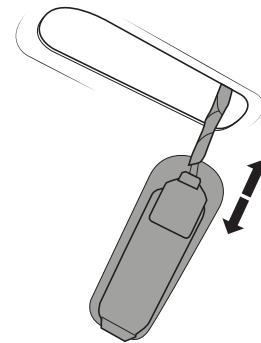
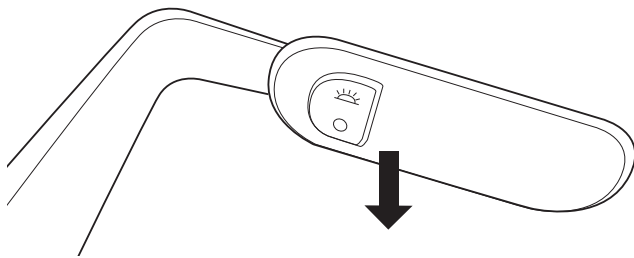

Release the sun visor bracket cover then move the visor to the side and extend it out then unscrew the Phillips head screws.



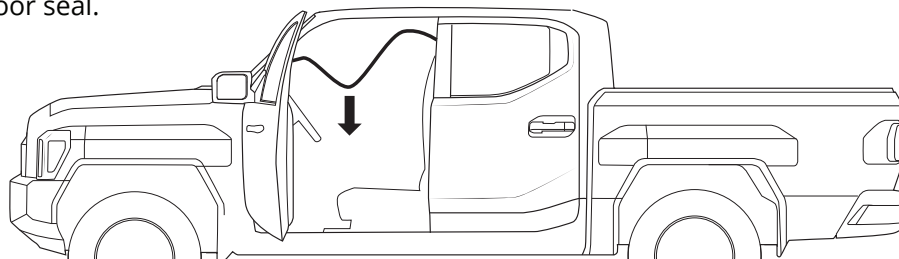

Pry off the sun visor light and disconnect the connector.



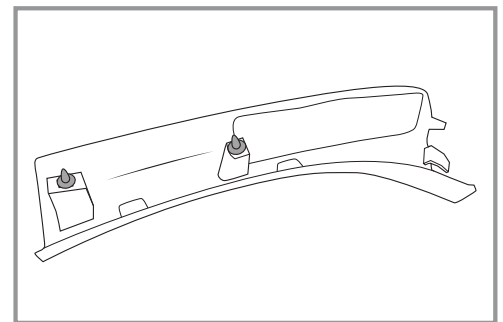
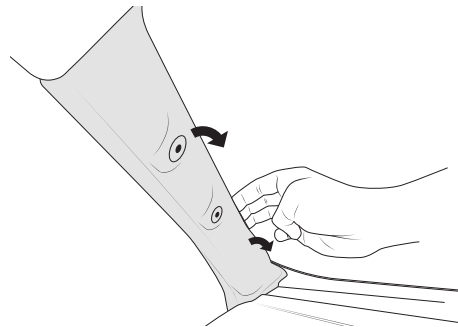

Release the passenger door seal.



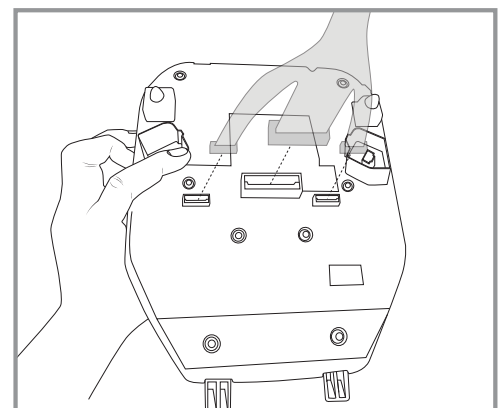
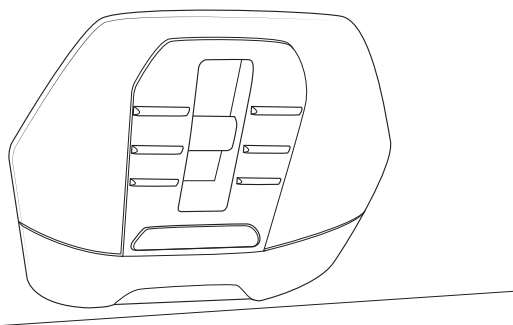

Pry off the A-pillar cover. There are two clips holding it in place. A trim tool may be needed for the upper clip.



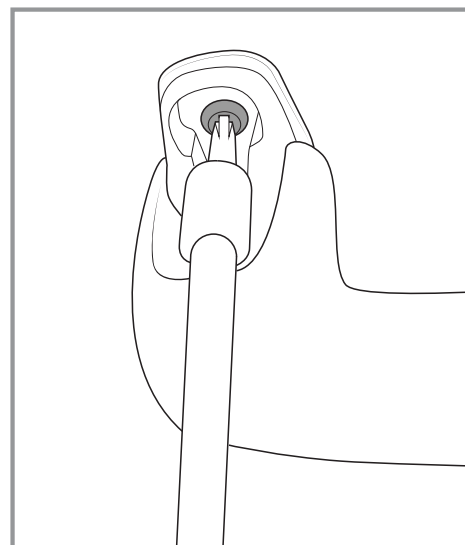
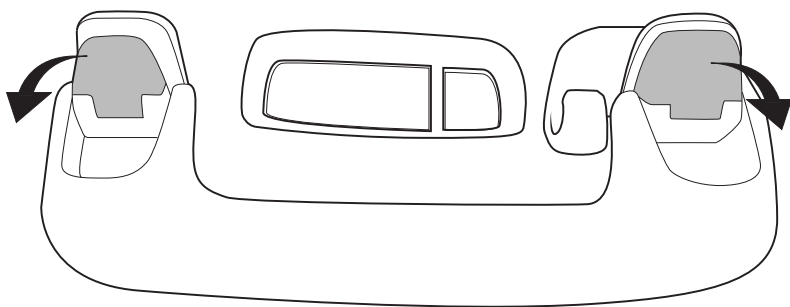

Moving to the passenger rear, remove the upper ceiling handle but prying the covers and releasing the two Phillips head screws.



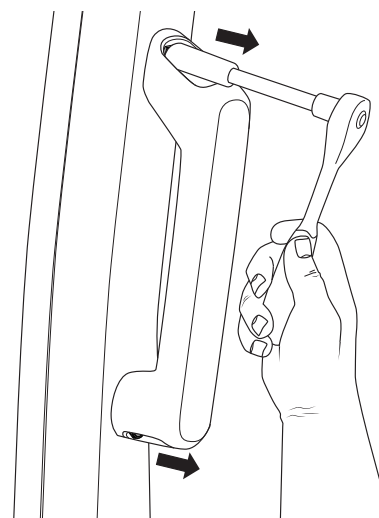
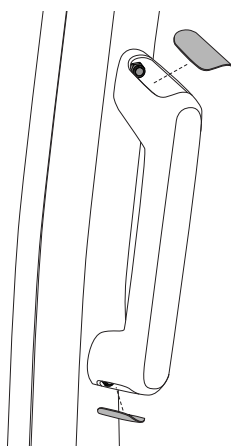

Pry the light off and disconnect the harness by using a screwdriver the release from the pins.



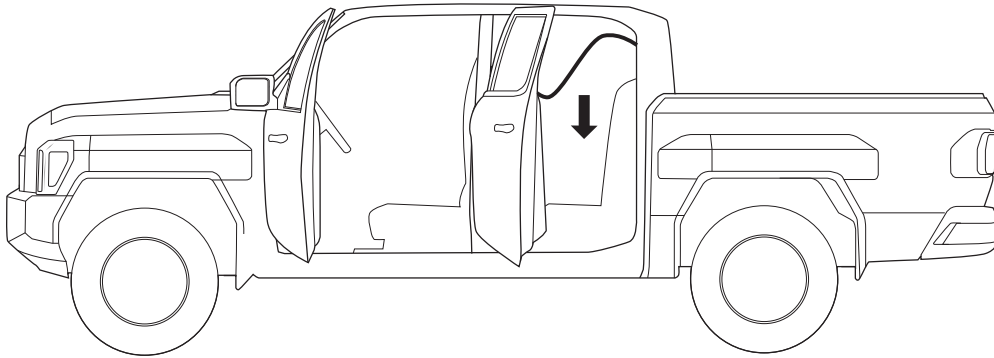

Release the B-pillar handle by releasing the covers and undoing the 10mm fasteners.



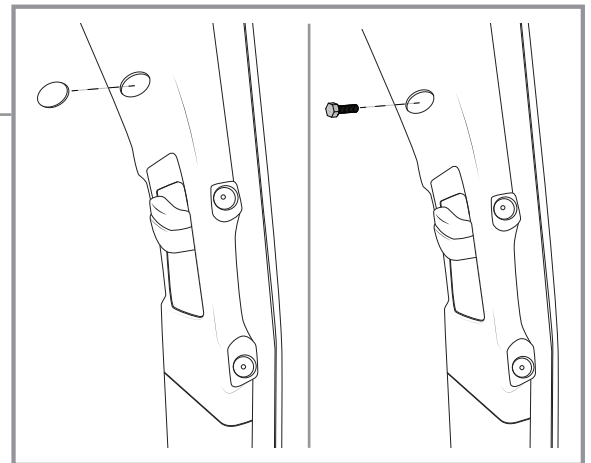
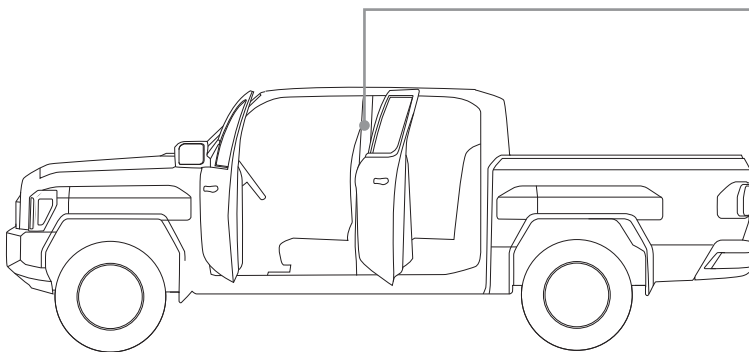

To remove the upper B-pillar trim, first release the airbag cover and undo the 10mm fastener.



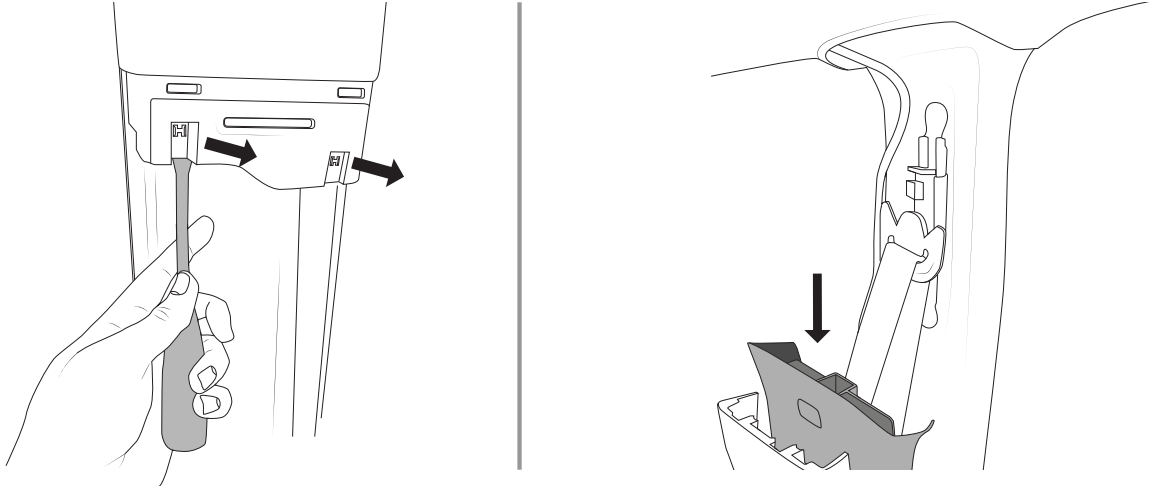

Release the lower B-pillar trim by prying from the sides, there will be two clips to remove.



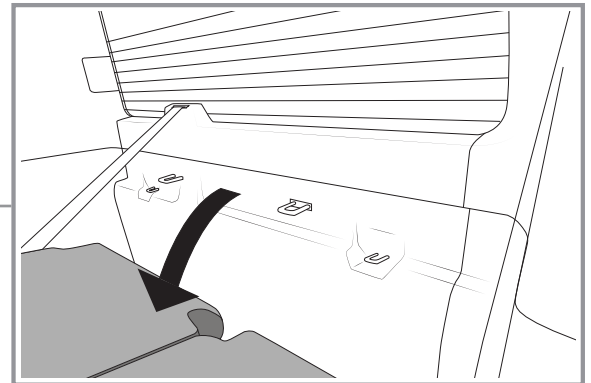
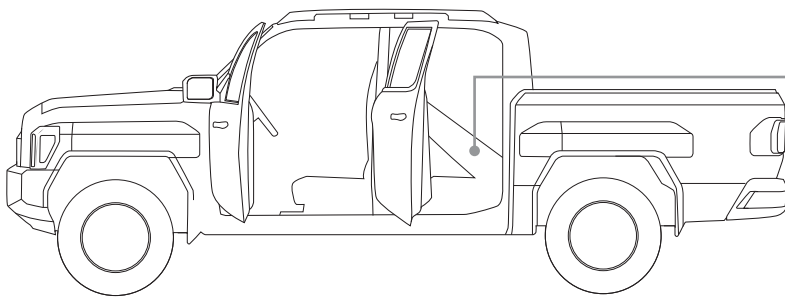

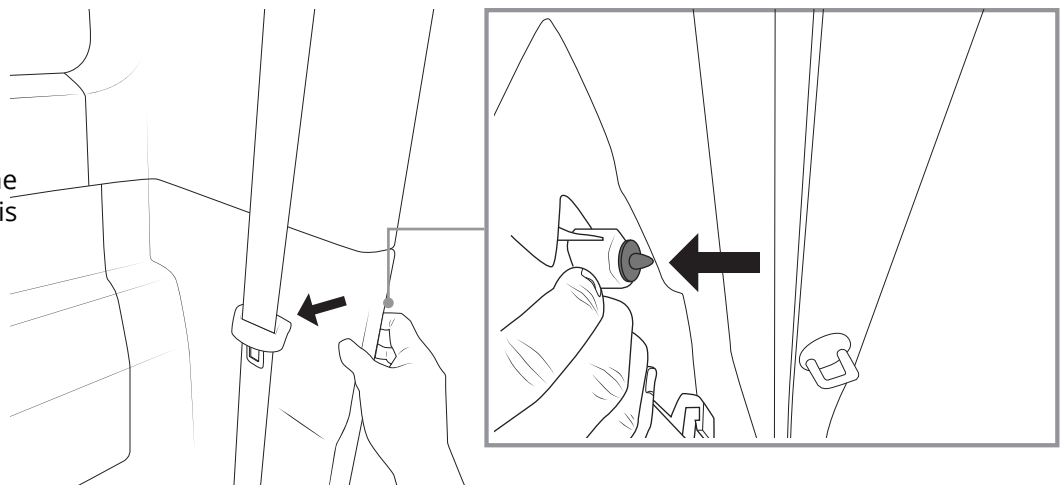
Fold the rear seats down to get access to the C-pillar trims.

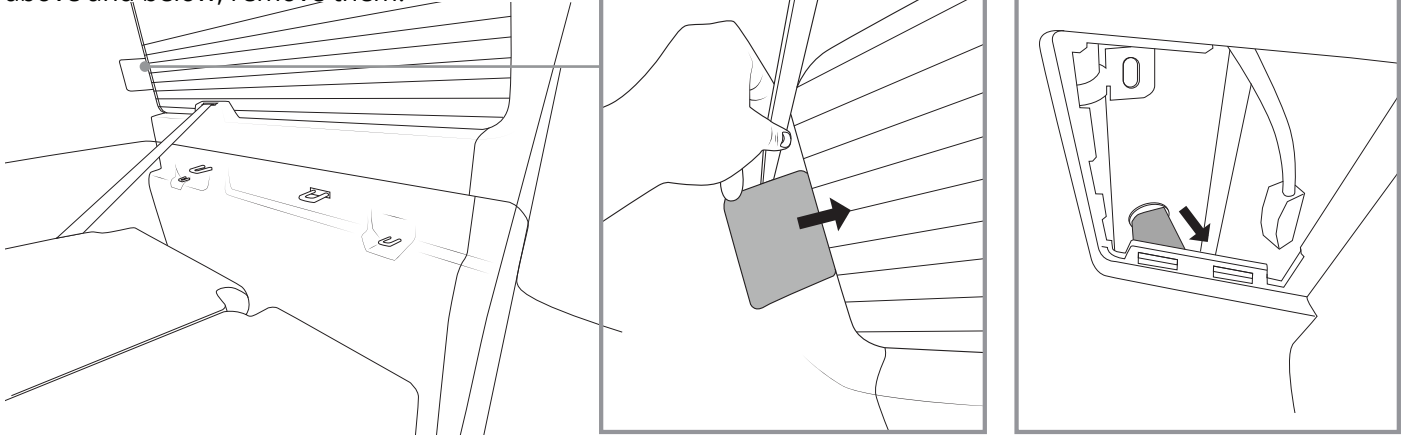
Partially release the lower C-pillar trim by prying the clips out.

NOTE: The trim will only release until the curve of the bodywork as shown, but this will give enough access for the upper C-pillar trim. Complete removal of this trim is not required.



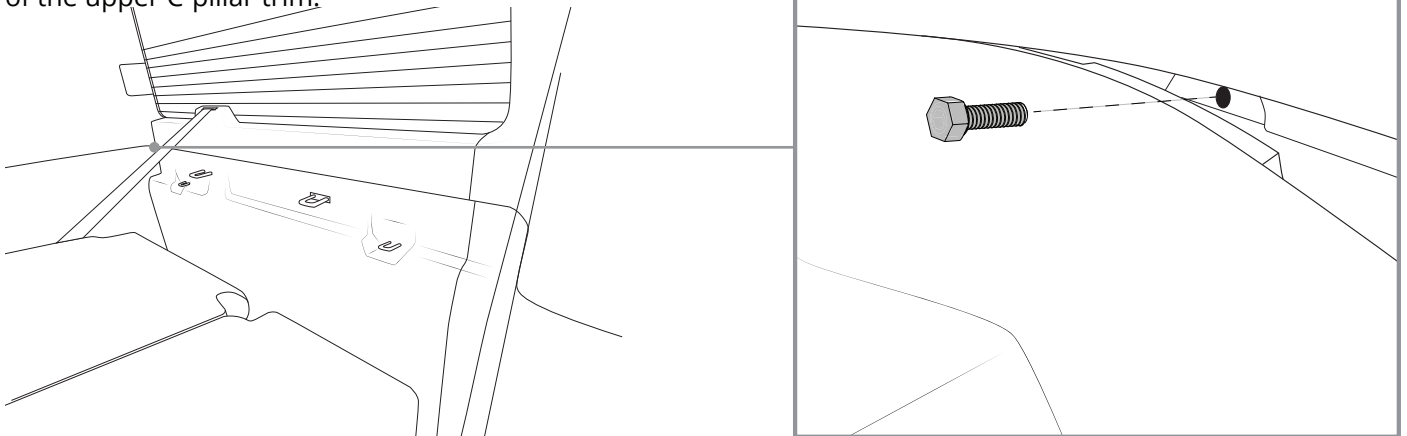

To release the upper C-pillar trim, first pry off the cover which will reveal access to two clips above and below, remove them.



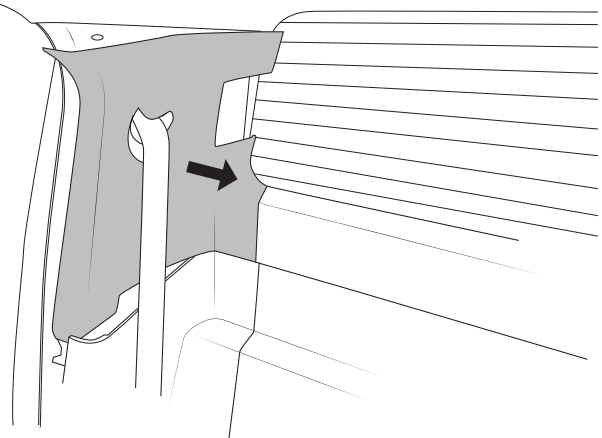

Remove the 10mm fastener at the bottom of the upper C-pillar trim.



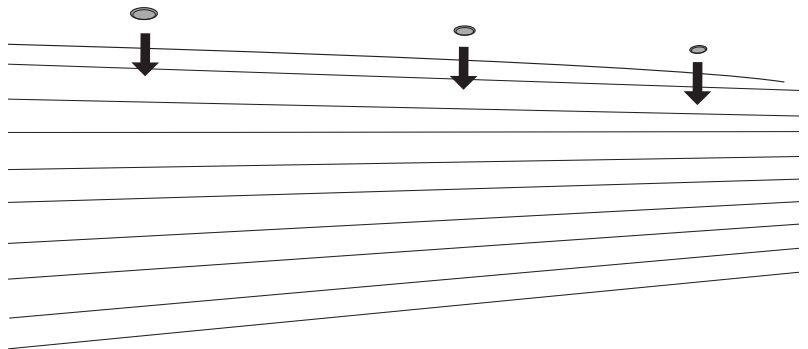

Remove the remaining clips of the C-pillar. Repeat previous steps for the drivers side of the vehicle.



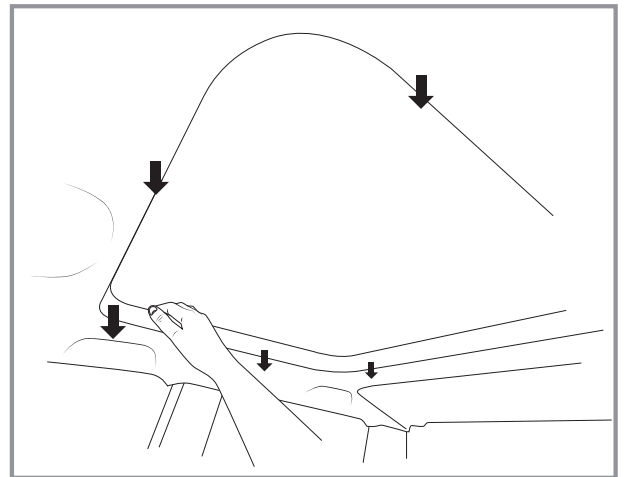
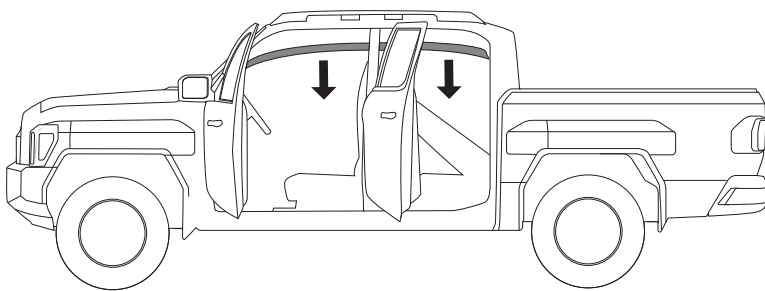
NOTE

The plastic tree plugs above the rear window, can be removed to assist in roof trim removal. However this will require replacement plugs, as they break on removal. This is not required to complete the fit.

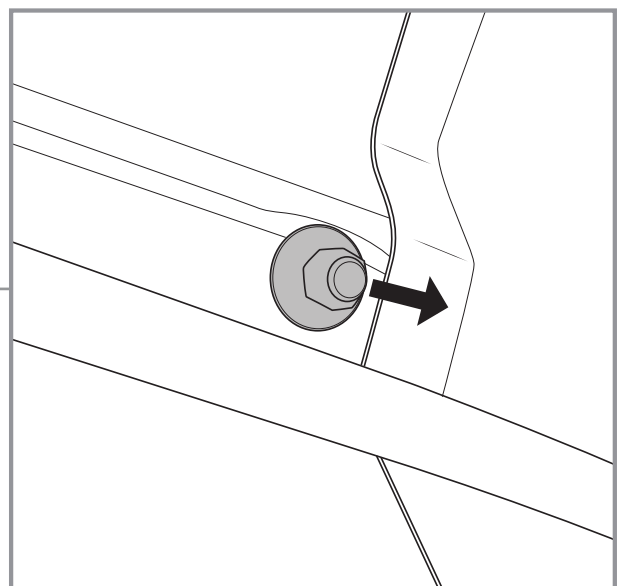
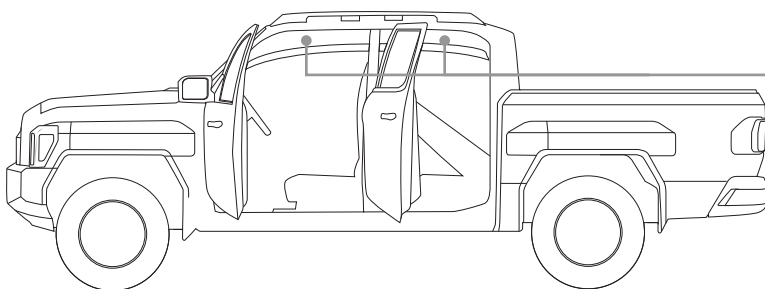
Release the velcro holding the roof liner to the vehicle and allow it to rest.

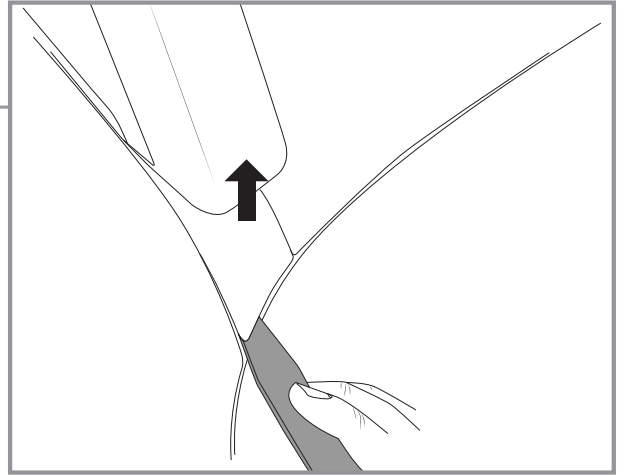
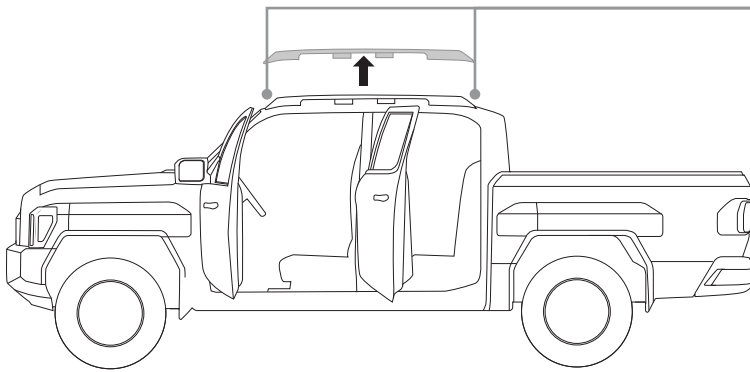

Release the newly exposed 10mm fasteners, holding the factory rail in place.



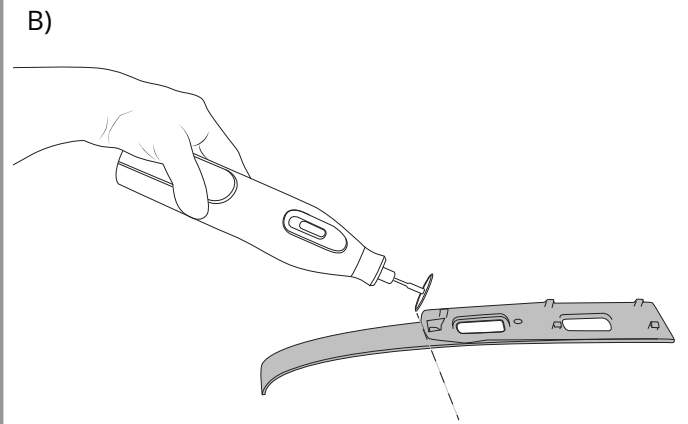
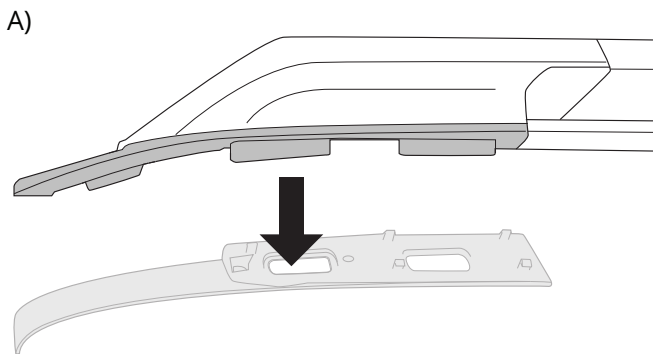

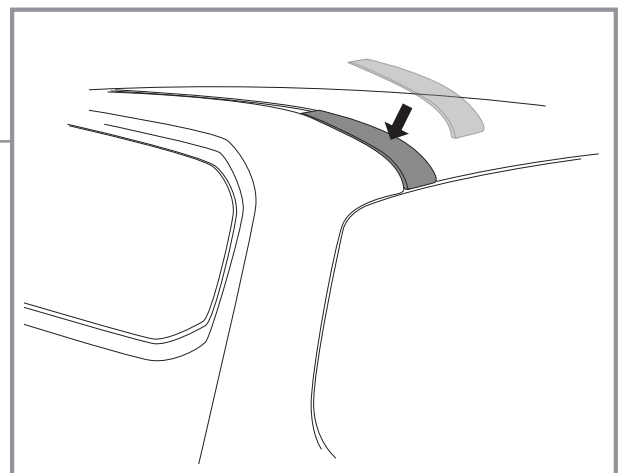
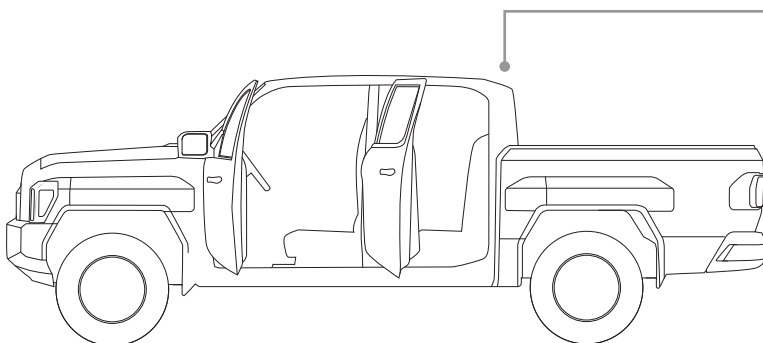
A) Remove the gutter cover at the rear of the factory rail.

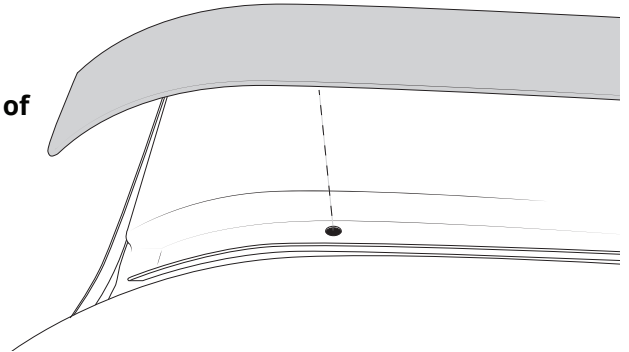
Reinstall the cut section of the factory trim to the vehicle. This will clip into place on the factory clip locations.

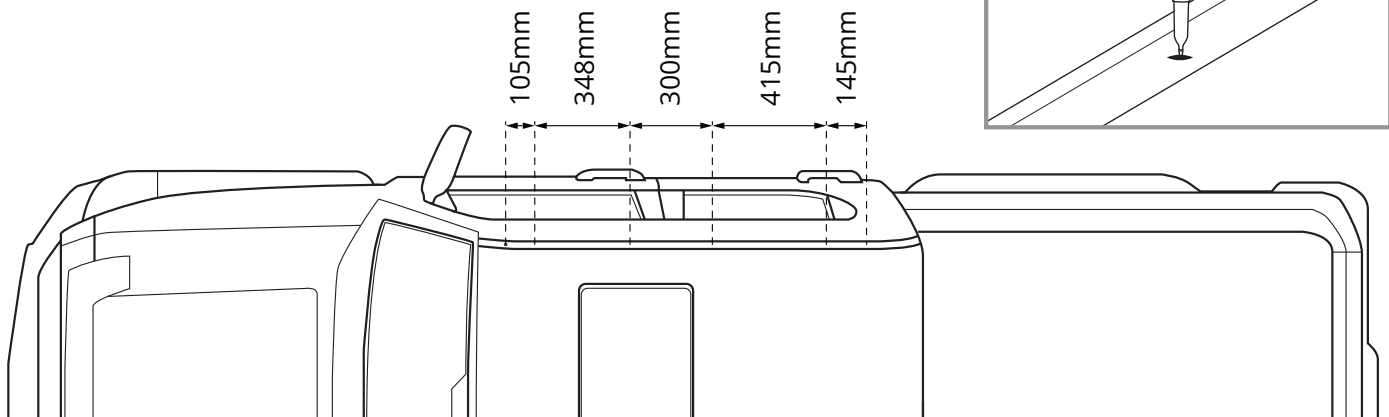
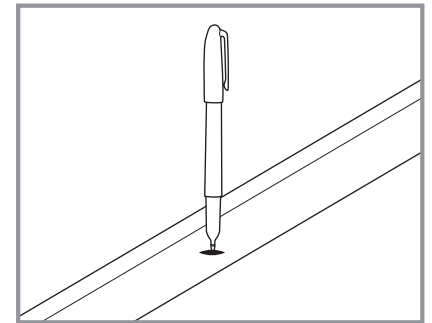
For S, SX & SX+ undo the 10mm fastener at the front of the vehicle and then release the clips for the factory gutter trim.

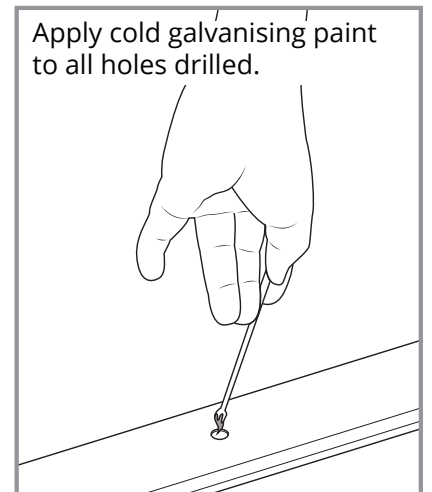
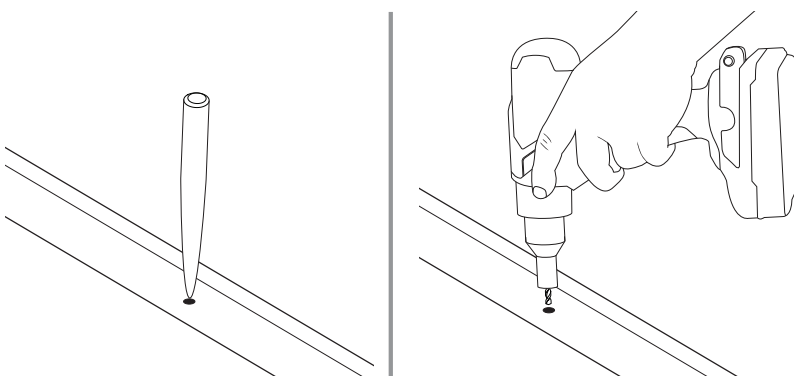
Measure back from the newly exposed hole at the front of the vehicle, using the dimensions shown. Using a marker, create a reference, centred in the gutter at these points.

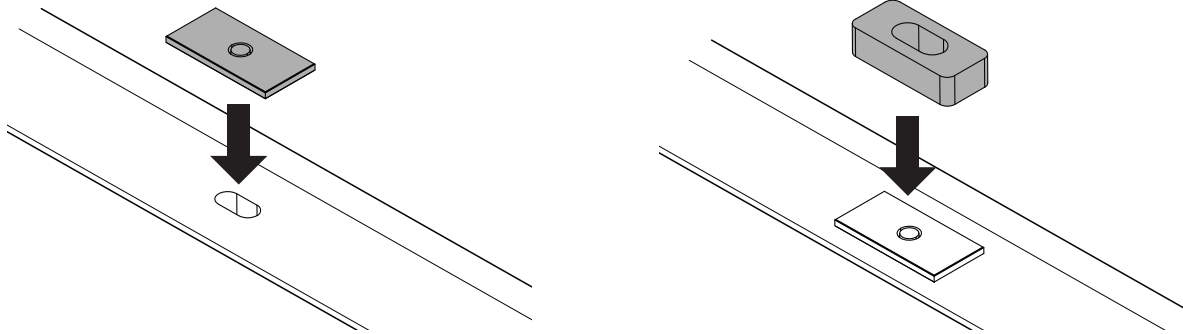
Centre punch the gutter at these points. Using a power drill and 2mm but, pilot mark these references. Open these pilot holes first with a 5mm bit, then a 6.5mm bit. Vacuum any swarf from the roof.

Apply cold galvanising paint to all holes drilled.

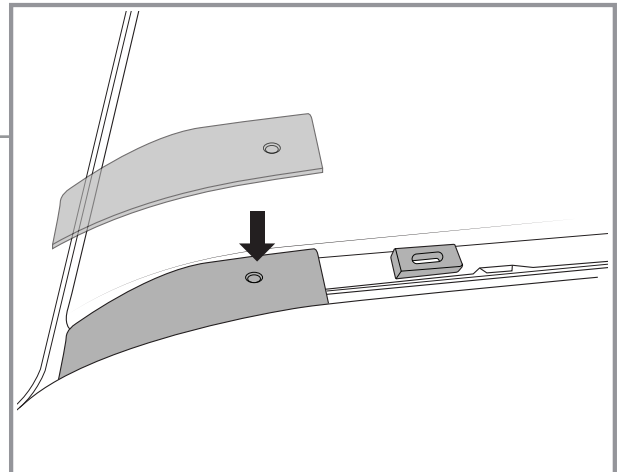
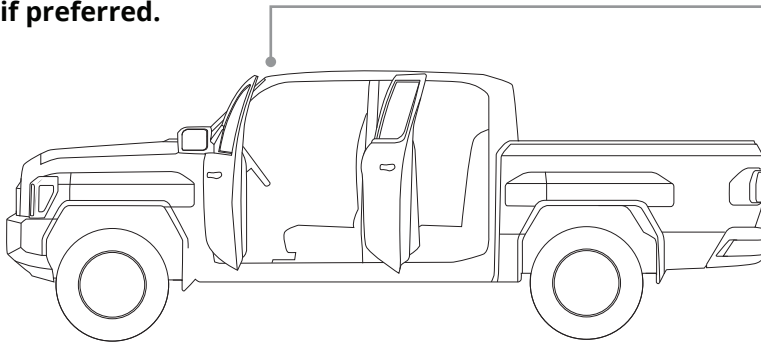
Place a butyl patch over each of the 6 cavities per side. Finally place a spacer over the top of the installed patch.

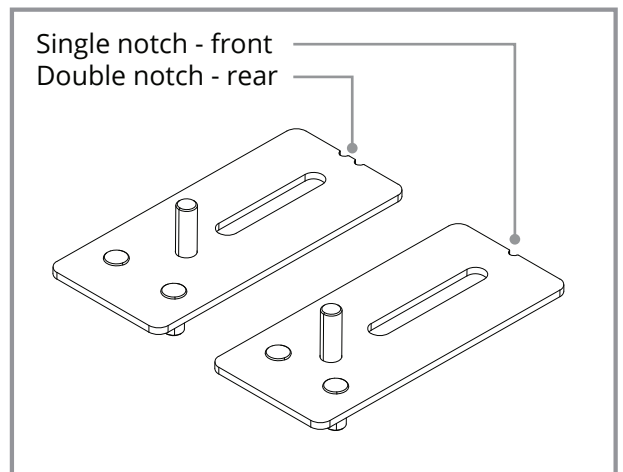
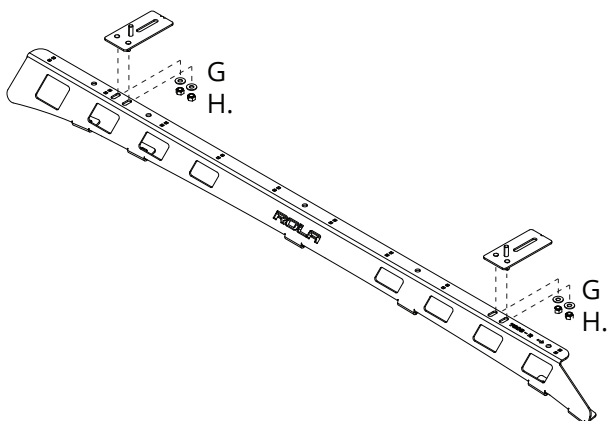
Fit the supplied front covers to the roof gutter. Align the hole in the cover to the first slot in the roof. These are labeled left and right.

NOTE: The factory trim can be cut and used instead if preferred.



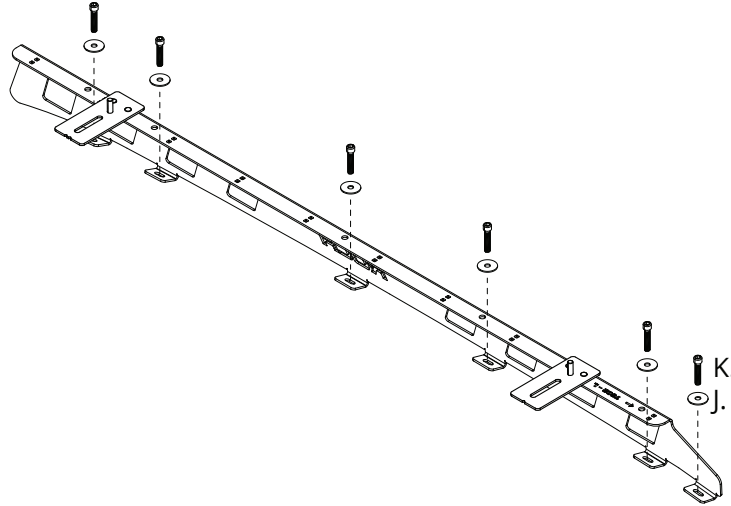
